Life Group Questions to consider:

1.) Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-6.

How do Paul's words challenge your view of your competence to judge in matters between church members? What would it look like if you accepted the responsibility to serve the church in this way?

2.) Read 1 Corinthians 6:7-8.

What approach do we take when we've been wronged? What would it look like if we turned the other cheek (Matthew 5:38-40)?

3.) Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11.

In what ways do we become deceived about unrighteousness in today's society? How does being washed, sanctified, and justified change your identity and your view?

4.) Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-14.

What unprofitable things do you pursue? What in your life has the potential to bring you under its power?

5.) Read 1 Corinthians 6:15-20.

Where is it challenging to submit to Christ's authority over your body? How is it difficult for you to flee immorality and live consistent with the fact that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to.

Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken. Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
