A VERSE

- God disturbs the sleep of kings.
 - ▶ This happens when Abraham, Joseph, Esther and Daniel were without power.
- He answers the prayers of men.
 - ▶ Daniel called a prayer meeting.
- He causes the rise and fall of nations.
 - ▶ Babylon
 - ✓ A city that becomes a by-word
 - ✓ At war with believers until the end!
 - ▶ Medo Persia
 - ✓ A great kingdom with two arms

- ▶ Greece
 - ✓ A kingdom of power but little value

- ▶ Rome
 - ✓ A kingdom starting as one but ending in ten toes (ten kings)
 - ✓ Only clear interpretation is it will have strength mixed with clay ... Brittle alliances.

- But only God knows when.

- ▶ Prophecy reminds us who holds the keys. It fixes our hope on the actions of God – not men.
