



Back-to-School Survey 2023

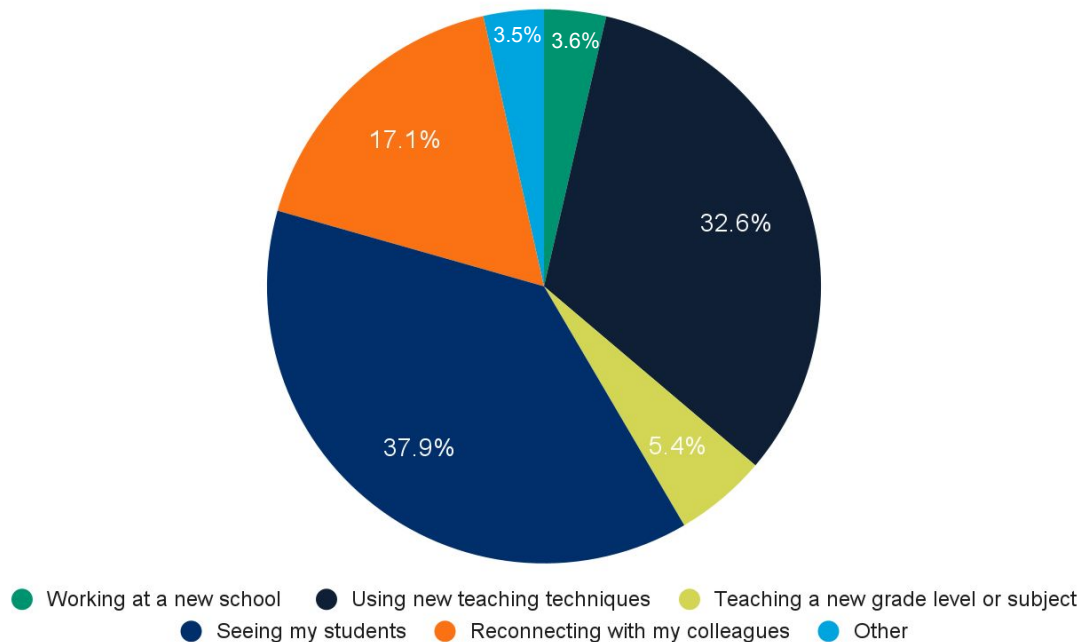
GoGuardian conducted this survey through its nationwide network of educators. The survey was conducted from July 12 through Aug. 2, and received 1,134 responses.



Survey Results: Back-to-School Sentiment

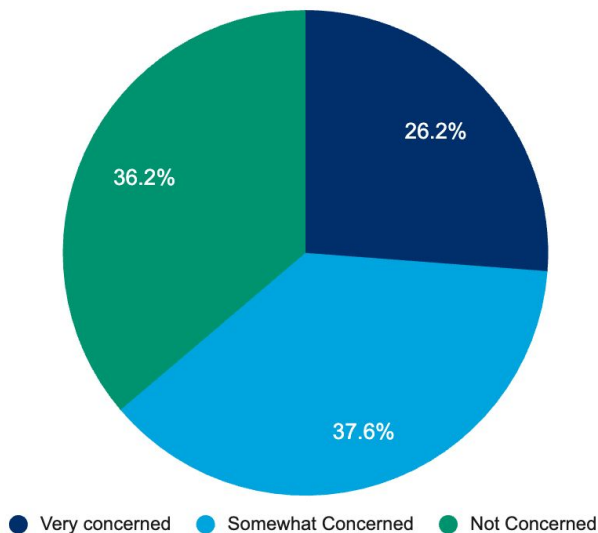
What are you most looking forward to in the 2022-2023 school year?

Given national education funding changes, how concerned are you about losing technology resources in your classroom?

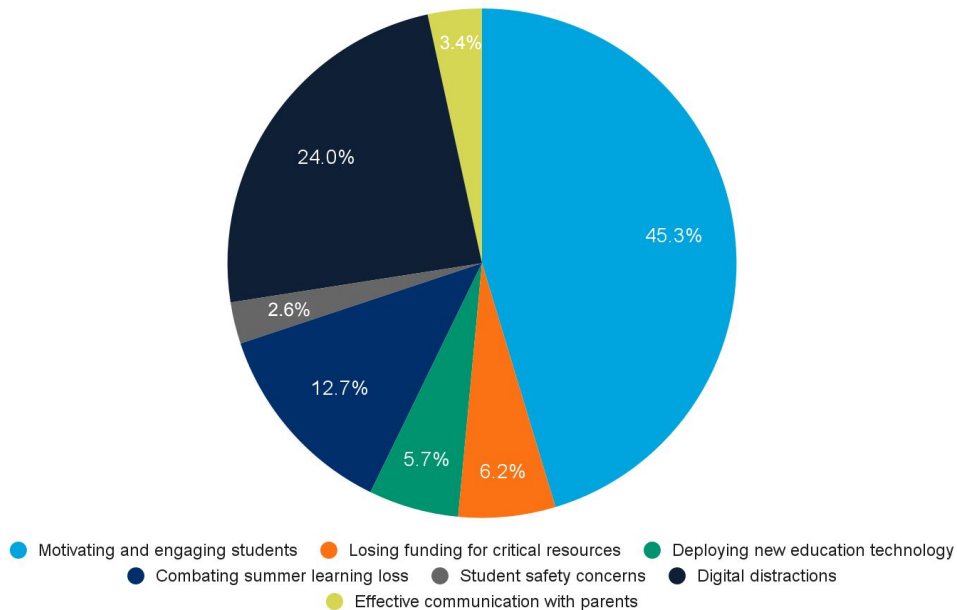
Educators were asked to select one multiple choice answer.

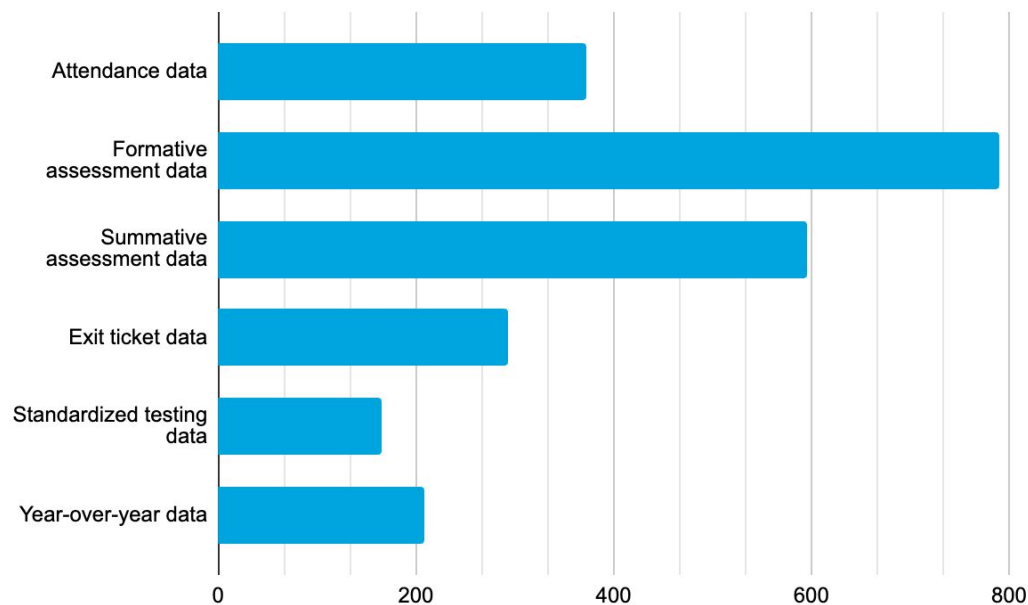
What do you anticipate will be your biggest challenge going into the 23-24 school year?

Educators were asked to select one multiple choice answer.



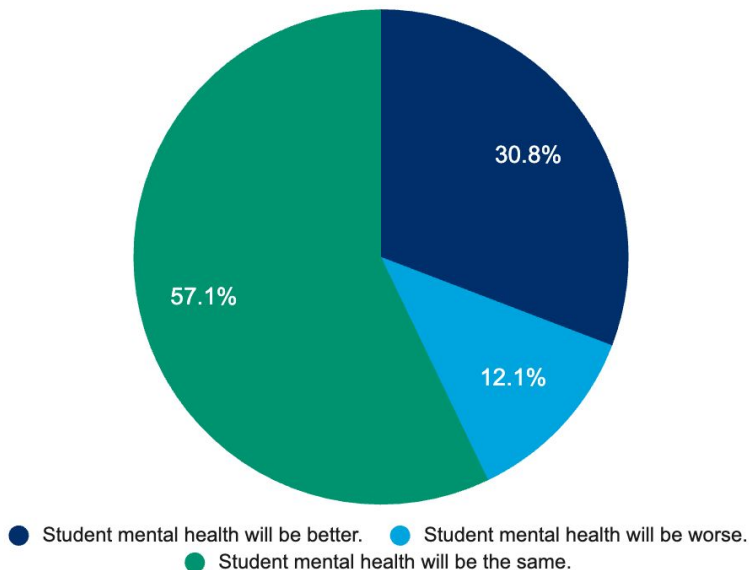
Which two data points are most important to you when reviewing student performance?

How do you anticipate student mental health will have changed from the 22-23 school year?

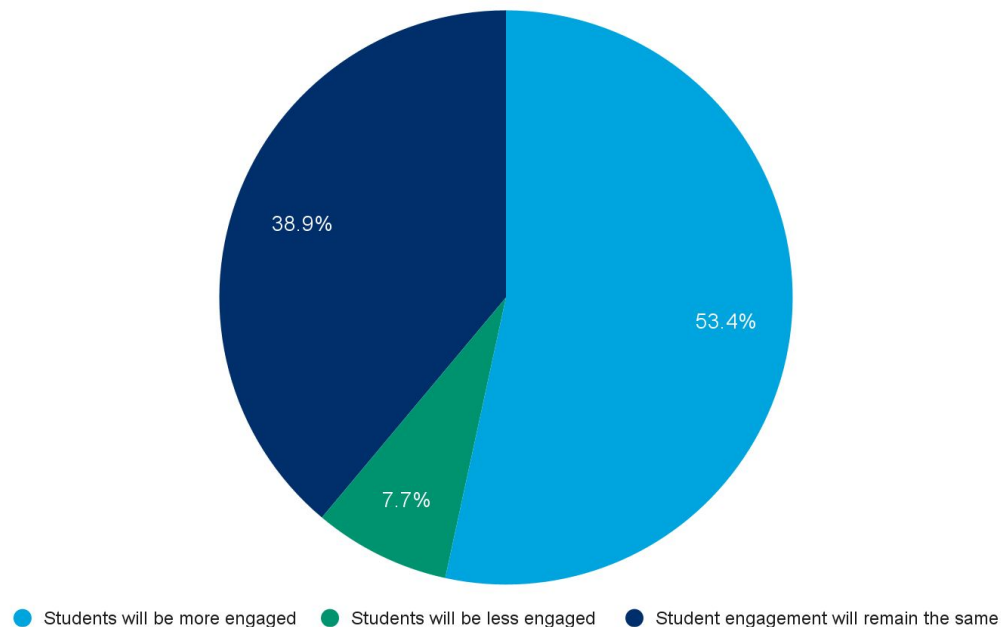
Educators were asked to select one multiple choice answer.

Will students be more or less engaged than they were last year?

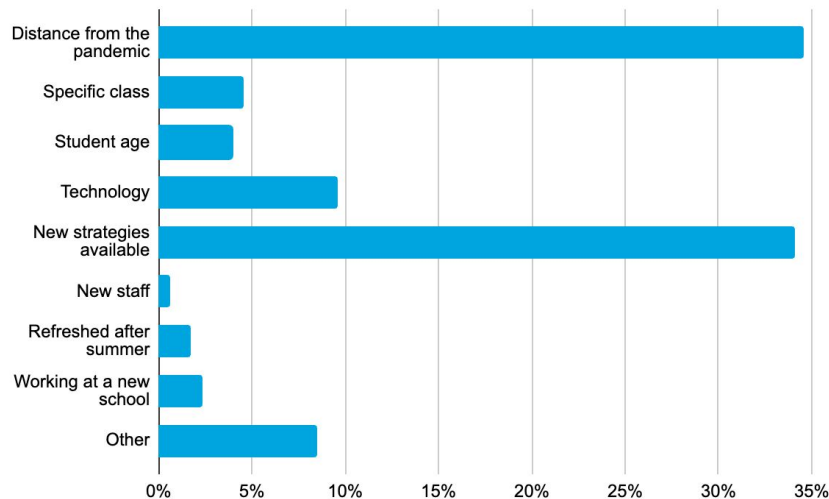
Educators were asked to choose only one of the below responses.



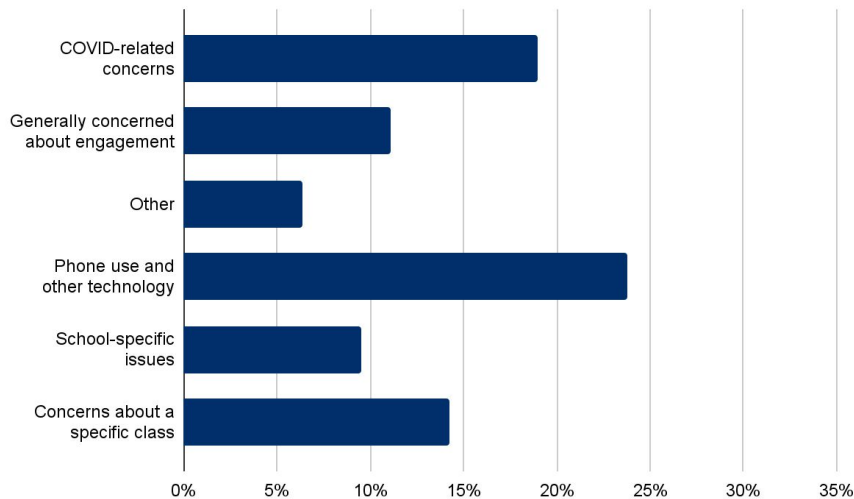
Will students be more or less engaged than they were last year?

If you answered more engaged, why?

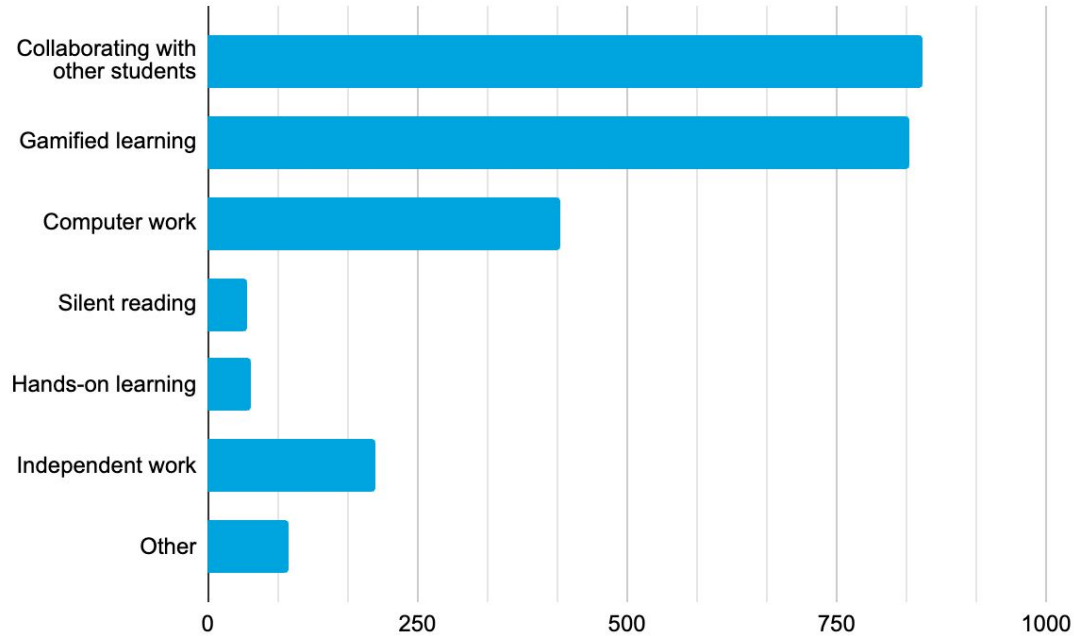


If you answered less engaged, why?



What do students get most excited about in your classroom?

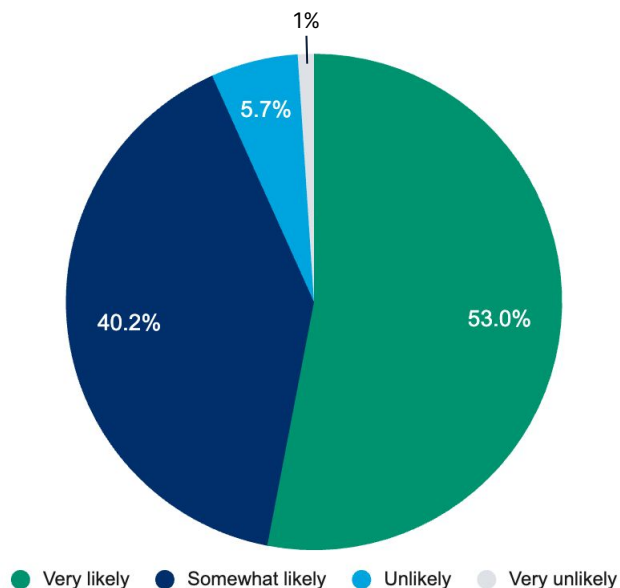
Educators were asked to choose up to three activities from pre-selected categories, or enter their own.



Survey Results: Educational Technology

In the 22-23 school year, how likely are you to implement an education technology product that you have never used before?

Educators were asked to choose one of the four multiple choice responses.



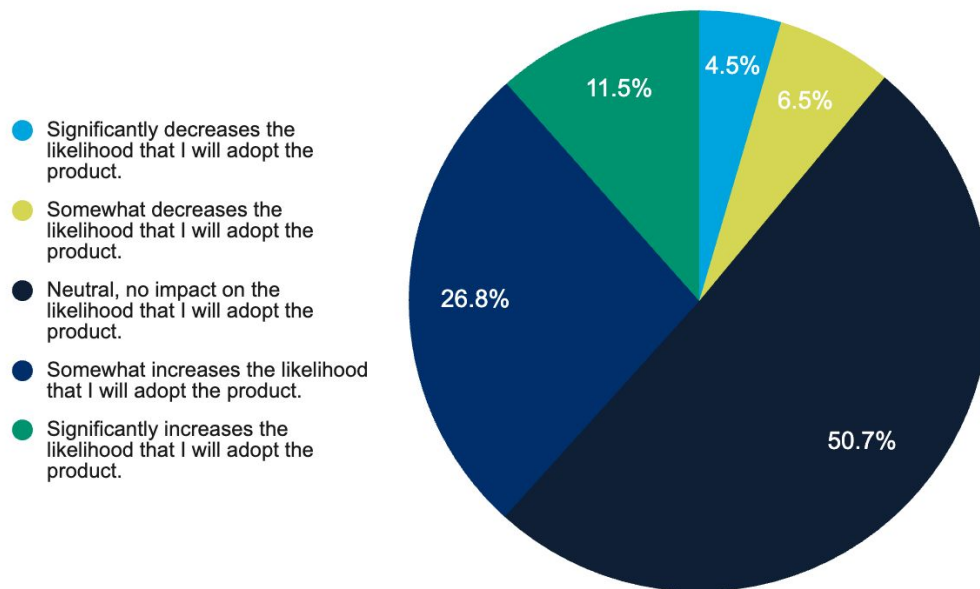
If so, which technology product do you plan to use?

Educators were asked to describe the technology products they plan to integrate into their classrooms.

- 622 educators responded, with answers spanning 149 different technology products.
- AI was heavily mentioned by respondents, with 14% of educators directly noting AI tools as a new product of interest.
- Many teachers noted that they aren't sure which tools they'll be using (20%), and some cited district or school decision-making as the determining factor.

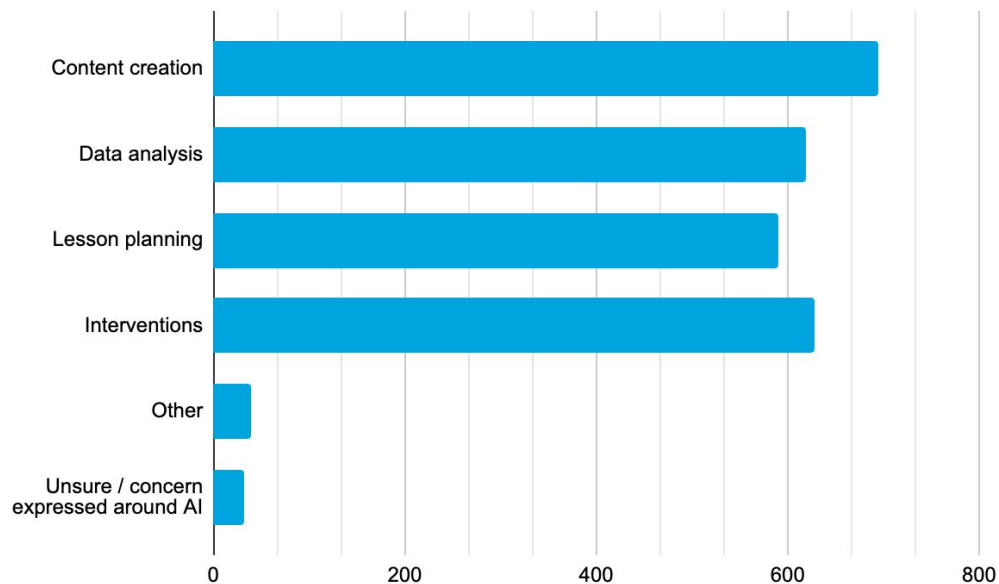
How does the inclusion of AI features impact the likelihood that you will adopt a product?
