Food Samples: Be prepared to provide tasting-sized food samples (recommend 3-5 oz. portions) for up to 500 guests.

Beverages: BrunchFest will feature a mimosa bar with complimentary beverages. Vendors can offer their own specialty cocktails. A cash bar will also be available.

Supplies: Each vendor will be assigned a clearly marked area including two tables and vendor signage. Electricity is available upon request. Vendors must supply all equipment necessary for the preparation, cooking, heating and serving. Cooking/warming source is <u>not</u> provided; Vendors are responsible for this equipment as needed.

Staff/Volunteers: If staffing your booth is a challenge, BrunchFest can secure volunteers for you. Please let us know if you need volunteers assigned to your station by Friday, May 19.
