

Hawke's Bay Scholarship

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society invites you to enter the 2022 Lawson Robynson Hawke's Bay Scholarship.

The Lawson Robynson Hawke's Bay Scholarship aims to recognise outstanding academic and leadership qualities in a student currently enrolled in a full time land based production industries programme at a New Zealand University.

The Lawson Robynson Hawke's Bay Scholarship recipient will receive \$3000 (*incl GST*), payable towards their course fees.

The Scholarship will be presented at the 2022 Napier Port Hawke's Bay Primary Sector Awards dinner, an event which celebrates excellence in the Primary Sector in Hawke's Bay.

The recipient must be a full time student enrolled in a New Zealand tertiary institute in a programme related to land based production industries at the Graduate or Postgraduate level.

Applicants must be in their final year of study when receiving this scholarship.

The recipient will have a familial association with Hawke's Bay and is or has been involved in the practical aspects of the industry to which the programme is linked.

The criteria for selection will be based on leadership potential and academic merit. It is hoped that scholarship recipients will ultimately seek employment in Hawke's Bay and pass on the benefits of their learning to the Hawke's Bay community and its industries.

The Scholarship will be awarded by a Selection Committee of three members comprising:

- A representative from Lawson Robynson.
- A representative from the Hawke's Bay Society.
- A recognised leader from the farming community selected and agreed by Lawson Robynson and The Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
