



The TCA Modular Cleanroom System

Modification Example:

In this rendering, we'll walk you through the steps in a typical cleanroom modification.

A. In our example, a pharmacy begins their compounding business with a simple 2 room Sterile Non-Hazardous Suite.

B. After 6 months of increased sales, the pharmacy sees an opportunity to add a Sterile Hazardous Suite to their existing cleanroom. Travis CleanAir is contacted and we begin modifying their first cleanroom suite, connecting a new Sterile Hazardous cleanroom to their existing suite.

C. Another 6 months have passed, and the pharmacy wants to add on a Non-Sterile Hazardous cleanroom to their existing suite. Travis CleanAir modifies their existing drawings per their specific requirements for their new cleanroom addition.

D. The pharmacy's final 4 room compounding suite, utilizing the TCA Modular Cleanroom System. Years in development with no loss to their initial investment, the pharmacy recommends TCA to another local pharmacy looking to expand their compounding needs.

E. The pharmacy, having operated now for 4 years, needs a larger facility to manage their increased compounding needs. Utilizing Travis CleanAir's modifying service, they were able to successfully move the 4 room suite to their new location.
