

Part I. General information.

Pursuant to Art. 13 sec. 1 and sec. 2 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in connection with the processing of personal data and on a free basis the flow of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general data protection regulation) (Journal of Laws EU.L.2016.119.1 of 04/05/2016), hereinafter hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we would like to inform you that:

- b) the processing of personal data is necessary for the purposes resulting from legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator or the website third.

Part III. Right to object to data processing for purposes direct marketing.

Moreover, pursuant to Art. 21 sec. 2 and sec. 4 GDPR, we inform you that:

- The data subject has the right to object to the processing of her personal data in the event of processing was used for direct marketing purposes, including profiling.
- The right to object is to the extent to which the data is processed personal data is related to direct marketing.
