Anti-Bribery & Corruption Policy

Corruption is dishonest behavior by people entrusted with power, such as government officials or managers, for private gain. Bribery is an example of corruption; giving or receiving something of value to gain an unfair advantage or to persuade someone to act improperly.

Corruption causes significant harm to society and the economy as it undermines trust in government institutions. It also harms competition and fair business practices. As bunq was established to promote a fair financial system we have no tolerance for such practices.

We have drawn up an Anti-Bribery & Corruption Policy to make sure that all bunq employees are aware of corruption and bribery risks and remain vigilant. There are clear guidelines for bunqers about receiving gifts or doing business transactions with companies that bunq does, or is planning to do, business with. Also our business partners should not be engaged in any act of corruption.

bunq does not, in any way, make charitable contributions or grant sponsorships that could be perceived as Bribery or Corruption. bunq does not sponsor political parties, politicians or political candidates.

We expect our employees to strictly comply with our Anti-Bribery & Corruption Policy and require them to report any (suspicion of) such conduct. When such a conduct is reported, we investigate and take necessary measures.
