





FAQ'S

When should I use this product? Generade Premium Liquid is designed for use in the lead up to transport, processing, yarding, shearing, or any other event that may cause stress. For best results treat the animals at least twice during the 24 to 36 hours prior to the stress event.

How should I store this product? Generade Premium should always be stored in a cool, dry location out of direct sunlight. Avoid exposure to temperatures of above 25 degrees Celsius.

Will it be OK if I pour several days worth into the water tank and leave it for a few days? Generade Premium contains soluble carbohydrates and if your water is dirty or contains bacteria, then it is likely that the bugs will rapidly ferment these freely available sugars and in turn cause changes to the color and taste of the water. We highly recommend adding the correct dose manually, on a daily basis, to Hay or Feed.

Is it safe to blend other treatments with Generade Premium? Generade Premium should not be added to any other proprietary treatment or product.

How do I apply or use Generade Premium? Calculate the correct dose for your number of animals and spread that quantity evenly over hay or grain. Make sure there is adequate feed for all animals to ensure even intake. Generade Premium is designed to be used at the rate of 150-200 ml/h/d cattle or 75-100 ml/h/d sheep. Your Accredited A.I.M. Advisor may vary this dosage depending upon your specific situation.

When treating Hay with Generade Premium, what quality of hay should I use? The quality of the hay is not critical, however we suggest that you ensure it is clean, dry and does not contain mould or contaminants. If you only have a few animals to treat, and a large amount of hay, you can mix Generade Premium with a small amount of water and pour the solution over the whole bale.
