Part 3 of 3 - Highest Pastoral Prayer Intentions for Culture

Parental Rights - It is the responsibility of the Catholic family to advocate for the most fundamental truths of humanity for the health of society, not just for Catholics - a foundational principal of natural law is recognizing and honoring the natural authority that the parents have for their own child. No individual or agency can usurp the natural law rights of the parent when they are parenting in accord with the natural law. On the national level we have seen the news of various school boards violating both constitutional and natural law rights of families when they exclude the parents from an awareness of educational materials. The three biggest themes where these violations have surfaced is in connection with (1) revisionist history lessons which some may refer to as critical race theory (2) transgender education and (3) sex education curricula. My focus in bringing this up is not to focus on these issues but to focus on how the parents are permitted or restricted from access to these newer educational materials which some parents find objectionable. As Catholics we want to preserve the dignity of parental rights especially as it pertains to the education of our children. Parents are the first educators of their own children, in manners, in responsibility, in love, in truth and in the faith. We must be aware and defend this natural law right of parents.



THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI



Have you ever wondered why there's a specific celebration for Corpus Christi (Latin for "Body of Christ")? Don't we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ at every Mass? Here are a few facts about this Holy Day.

- *Established by Pope Urban IV on September 4, 1264*
- *A Feast Day for the sole purpose of celebrating the Holy Eucharist*
- *Celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday*

HISTORY

Saint Juliana of Liège (1193-1258), who had a great reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, began the cause for the feast day of Corpus Christi. She thought that the Eucharist deserved its own exclusive day of reverence and recognition. This day would be apart from Holy Thursday when the Church focuses on not only the Eucharist but the washing of the feet, ordained priesthood, and Jesus in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Saint Juliana was motivated by a recurring vision of the Church as a full moon with one dark spot, which she interpreted as the absence of a specific reverence to the Holy Eucharist. She worked more than 40 years for the cause until her death. In her later years, she gained the support of Jacques Pantaléon, at the time Archdeacon of Liège, and other Church leaders. Pantaléon was later elected Pope Urban IV and went on to establish the Feast of Corpus Christi.

This year as a Parish we will celebrate Corpus Christi by having a Eucharistic procession following the 4:30 pm Saturday Evening Mass and the 11:00 am Sunday Morning Mass. Eucharistic Adoration will follow all other Masses.

Bishop Malloy will have a procession following the 11:00 am Mass at the Cathedral of St. Peter in Rockford. All are welcome to join Fr. Trowbridge for this Mass & procession with Bishop Malloy.

La Santísima Trinidad

“En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo”. Al santiguarnos, pues, no lo hagamos tan aprisa y balbuceando la oración que nos encomienda a la Trinidad y nos ayuda a comprometernos como bautizados al servicio del Reino de Dios. La Trinidad es un misterio de amor y de entrega, y cada año, la Liturgia nos propone reflexionar en las tres personas que la componen: Dios Padre, Dios Hijo y Dios Espíritu Santo. Es el misterio más grande del cristianismo. Donde Dios se revela como comunidad de vida y de amor que existe en la Trinidad. Un solo Dios verdadero, en tres personas distintas.

“El Señor ordenó bautizar en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. El catecúmeno es bautizado profesando por ello la fe en el Creador, en el Unigénito y el Don. Solo uno es el Creador de todo, ya que uno solo es Dios Padre, de quien procede todo; uno es también el Unigénito, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, por medio del cual todas las cosas fueron creadas; y uno solo es el Espíritu, que a todos nos ha sido dado” (San Hilario de Poitiers (315-367) Sobre la Trinidad). “La Santísima Trinidad es la luz del tiempo pascual y de Pentecostés, renueva cada año en nosotros la alegría y el estupor de la fe: reconocemos que Dios no es una cosa vaga, nuestro Dios no es un Dios ‘spray’, es concreto, no es abstracto, sino que tiene un nombre: ‘Dios es amor’. No es un amor sentimental, emotivo, sino el amor del Padre que está en el origen de cada vida, el amor del Hijo que muere en la cruz y resucita, el amor del Espíritu que renueva al hombre y al mundo” (Papa Francisco). ¡Amén! ©LPi
