PROCESS TO CLAIM UNCLAIMED DIVIDEND AMOUNT AND EQUITY SHARES FROM INVESTOR EDUCATION AND PROTECTION FUND (IEPF).

Submit self-attested copy of e-form, copy of acknowledgement, Indemnity Bond in original along with other documents as mentioned in the form to Nodal Officer, Ms. Shachi Sanghavi, of the Company, at its Corporate office, in an envelope marked "Claim for refund from IEPF Authority" within 10 days of filing.

VERIFICATION OF CLAIM

Company to send the verification report to IEPF within 15 days of filing of the claim.

> REFUND OF CLAIM

On the basis of the Verification report refund will be released by the IEPF Authority in favour of the claimant's bank or Demat account through electronic transfer.

Kindly also note the following:

- a) In case the claimant is a legal heir or successor or nominee of the registered holder, transmission process has to be completed by him with the company before filing the claim and procure entitlement letter in favour of legal heir.
- b) Claimant to make only one consolidated claim in a financial year.

In view of the aforesaid the Company recommends and request the shareholders to claim their refund at the earliest.
