<u>On public roads</u> it is REQUIRED that you contact the Road District before work begins. Please mark the proposed approach for approval.


DIMENSIONS

- □ An unobstructed minimum width of 12-feet and height of 15-feet is required for emergency vehicles.
- □ Driveways in excess of 150 feet shall provide turnarounds measuring 10-feet wide and 30-feet long.
- ☐ Gravel shall be a minimum of 4-inches in depth.
- □ Material may be natural aggregate.
- □ Surface material may <u>NOT</u> be larger than 1-inches in diameter and shall be free of foreign material.
- □ Driveways must be designed and surfaced to provide all-weather access.




CULVERTS

- □ Culverts shall be installed in line with the road ditch.
- □ Culverts shall be a minimum of 12-inches in diameter.
- ☐ Minimum culvert length is 30-feet, and works well in most cases.
- □ A 3-foot horizontal to 1-foot vertical slope is required from the aggregate edge to the top of the culvert.
- □ Culverts may not be located within 10-feet of a cross culvert, unless directed by the Road District.
- □ Driveway approaches shall be a minimum of 2% slope down/away from the road shoulder.
