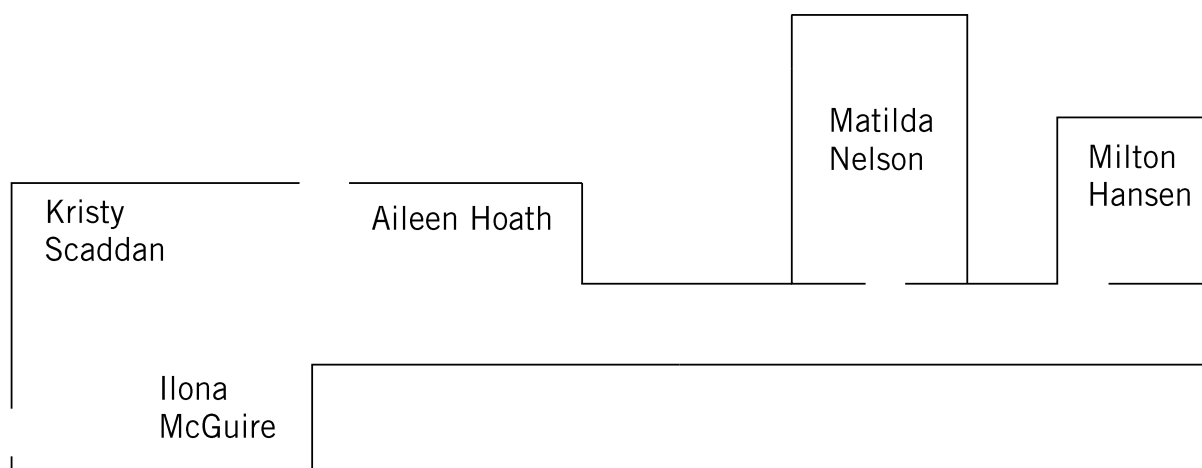

- 1-30 *Permutation*, 2022, dragon palm leaf with various combinations of dyed and natural plant fibres, thread, wire, found electronic and construction waste materials and copic ink pen . \$55 each, three for \$150
- 31-35 *Spiky Permutation*, 2022, dragon palm leaf, collated screw spines, various thread, wire, raffia found electronic waste materials. \$95 each, all five for \$400
- 36 *Shadowing*, 2022, suspended structure, found TV antennae, dyed and natural plant materials including palm leaf, rushes, grasses and raffia, wire and found electronic waste. \$350, \$850 with all hanging items 37-50
- 37-50 *Spiny Permutation (Shadowing)* 2022, suspended items, dragon palm leaf, electronic connector spines, thread, wire found electronic waste materials. \$55 each, three for \$150
