EXPLAINING DOBBS V. JACKSON WOMEN'S HEALTH ORGANIZATION

On December 1, the Supreme Court heard oral arguments in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. This case could wind up being the most significant Supreme Court decision regarding abortion since 1973's Roe v. Wade. Here's what's going on:

What's the controversy? Mississippi passed a law that bans abortion after 15 weeks of pregnancy. Planned Parenthood v. Casey (Roe's 1992 "successor" case which largely controls modern US abortion law) says that the Constitution prevents states from banning abortion prior to fetal "viability," the point when a fetus can survive delivery, roughly 22-24 weeks after conception. Abortion providers have sued Mississippi, arguing that its law is unconstitutional by the Casey standard. The Court is reconsidering that standard, and will answer this question: may states ban abortion before fetal viability?

What could happen? There are two likely outcomes. If the Court says that states may not ban abortion before viability, Casey and Roe's status quo will remain: abortion will remain legal nationwide, for all 9 months of pregnancy and for any reason, with no ability for states to ban abortion as such. If the Court says that states may ban abortion before viability, each state can regulate abortion however it wants, up to banning it outright. This would overturn Roe v. Wade.

What was the Court doing on December 1? The two sides in the lawsuit presented their "oral arguments" to the Court. During oral arguments, each side's lawyers physically stand in front of the Court and give their arguments for their position, while the nine justices pepper them with questions. Both sides had already presented extensive, written briefs to the Court prior to the oral arguments.

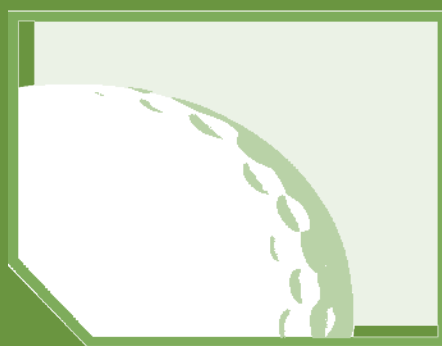
What Happens Next? Over the next several months, the justices will decide on their views, and write their various opinions, with the majority writing the controlling opinion. They will issue their ruling likely in June.

How Will the Court Rule? While nothing is certain, I personally believe the Court will indeed overturn Roe v. Wade. Of the 6 Republican-appointed justices on the Court, only Chief Justice Roberts seemed inclined to look for any kind of "compromise," to maintain limited Constitutional protection for abortion. The questions from the other five "conservative" justices indicated that they were strongly leaning towards overturning Roe and Casey. Justice Kavanaugh, whom many view as the Court's "swing" vote, asked a series of particularly promising questions about the Court's ability to reverse its prior precedents.

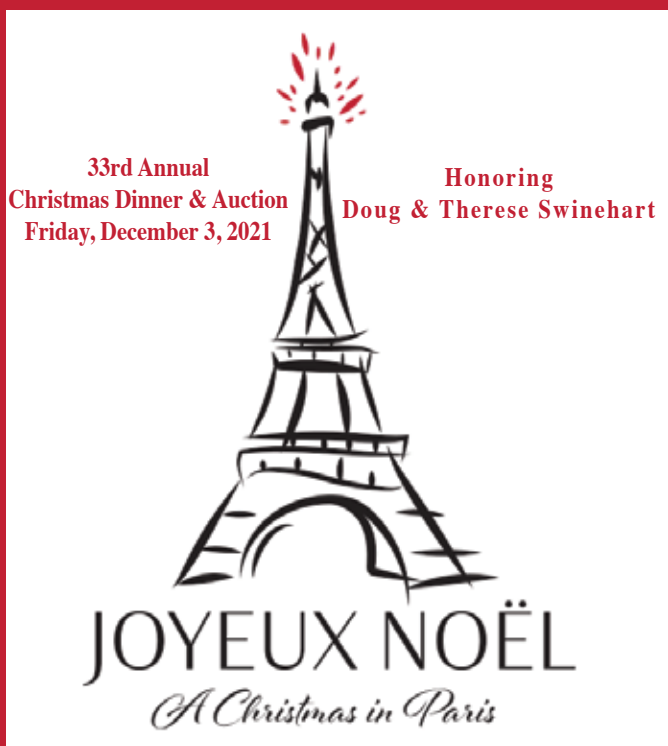

ENCOURAGING WOMEN IN CRISIS

I am continually trying to think of ways to encourage those who are walking from their car to the entrance of Planned Parenthood to come talk to us first. Shouting doesn't work. It never has and never will. Pleading doesn't either. Offering something for free might, but even that is subjective. What seems to work is offering a flower. It doesn't even matter what kind. It seems we just like flowers. For some reason we are attracted to them. Fortunately, we have had a few instances when the offer of a flower has been a great way to attract someone to have a conversation.

In October I had a situation where a young woman was lingering outside of Planned Parenthood looking upset, so I offered her a flower. She looked up, walked over, and we started to talk. She told me she was pregnant and scared. I asked if she'd like to talk at our Outreach building. She said yes.

I showed her the baby models we have and explained where I thought she was in her pregnancy according to what she told me. She started to smile.

We sat down, and she talked about all her concerns. It's a scary thing to have your life completely turned upside down. She was scared. Fortunately, she has a supportive partner and also a network of family and friends. At one point she remarked "I am pro-life, you have helped me to see this". Once this happened, I called Sarah on FaceTime so our new mom would have a chance to talk to another person who would be supportive and compassionate. By the end of their conversation, our mom was talking about whether the baby would be a boy or a girl.

When we called her partner, she had the confidence to tell him that she was choosing life. He told her he'd support her completely. She is not only choosing life; she is choosing to live joyfully, and he is keeping his promise. Yesterday I had the honor of attending an ultrasound appointment with them. She is midway through her pregnancy, and I look forward to seeing them become a family.
