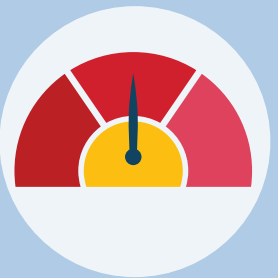




Prince2 is the government standard method for IT systems in the UK, and getting a certification in the system is often a necessity for project manager jobs at a high level.



Prince2 uses six core performance indicators which are **risks, quality, benefits, scope, timescale and cost** and they inform the seven principles.



There are defined roles in the Prince2 approach which include a product manager, a team of specialists that includes a team manager and a project board.



The workflow of a Prince2 project is broken up into stages. Each stage deals with a single aspect of the project and goes through a detailed roadmap that begins with initiation, goes through directing, controlling and managing and ends with a formal closure.



Every project must go through a process of tailoring to the environment. Prince2 works for all kinds of projects but will need to be adapted to suit specific **goals and capabilities**.
