

# SCRUM

## - THE BASICS



The name of the method comes from a play in rugby in which the team has to work together to progress, and this is what the Scrum approach aims to apply to project management.



An essential element of Scrum is the Product Backlog, which is a list of requirements for the project that are listed by priority.



There are three primary roles in Scrum: The Product Owner, the Development Team, and the Scrum Master, and each of them play a vital part in the process.



A Scrum project is broken up into 'events', most of which are components of the 'sprints'. These include the Sprint Planning, Sprint Review & Sprint Retrospective.



Scrum is a part of the overall Agile methodology, but it differs from it because it has a specific list of rules and guidelines.
