## QUESTIONS

- How did God tell Paul and Silas where to go?
- What was the name of one of the women Paul and Silas met by the river? What was her profession?
- What happened when Lydia heard Paul's message about Jesus?
- Read Matthew 28:18–20. What does Jesus ask us to do?
- If you could go anywhere in the world, where would you want to go?
- Why is it important that God's message go everywhere?
- What will you do to help spread the Good News of Jesus?

## ACTIVITY: Find the Countries

On the back of this paper is a list of the 68 countries where Cornerstone Church helps missionaries spread the message of Jesus. Find a world map. Then find the listed countries on the map. For younger kids, you could find the regions instead. You could also print out the map then color in or put a sticker on the countries. Hang the list somewhere in your house where everyone will see it.
