Bible Story: Daniel in Babylon – Daniel 1
Read Together: Galatians 6:9; Philippians 2:14-15

Questions

- How did Daniel and his friends end up in Babylon?
- What did the four of them do differently from others who were brought to Babylon?
- What happened because of this choice they made?
- Have you ever made a hard choice that was different than the people around you?
- When have you given up on something and now you regret it?
- Daniel and his friends supported each other. When should you ask for help from friends or family?
- How can a lesson you learn now in a hard situation help you to trust God in the future?

Family Activity: Build a Zoo

Work together to make a zoo. You can use pieces of paper and draw the zoo as a 2D map, or you could make a 3D zoo using small plastic animals, animals you draw and cut out of cardboard, or stuffed animals. Make "exhibits" for the animals using materials like boxes (empty cereal and pasta boxes are great to cut up), legos, blocks, or laundry baskets.

Just like you planned your zoo, God has a plan for you life. God will help you learn to trust Him and to trust the people He puts in your life when you ask Him for help. This week, pray together as a family that you won't give up when things get hard. Ask for God's help to be like Daniel and do what you know is right without complaining or arguing.
