

BASIL—OCIMUM



Ocimum basilicum 'Cinnamon'
'Cinnamon' Basil

H: 18" 45cm Zone: 9
Known for its darker colour and spicy, cinnamon-like aroma and taste. Has distinctive cinnamon-coloured stems.



Ocimum basilicum 'Genovese'
Sweet Large Leaf Basil

H: 24-36" 60-90cm Zone: 9
This Italian variety has extremely tender, fragrant, extra-large, dark green leaves and is superb for pesto.



Ocimum x citriodorum
Lemon Basil

H: 8" 20cm Zone: 7
Attractive, spreading silver-green plant with lemony aroma and great flavour.



Ocimum basilicum 'Anise'
'Licorice' Basil

H: 18-24" 45-60cm Zone: 9
An uncommon basil with a rich licorice-anise like aroma mixed with classic basil.



Ocimum basilicum 'Purple Ruffles'
'Purple Ruffles' Basil

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 9
Named for its ruffled, purple leaves that have a rich, complex flavor and aroma. Pinkish purple summer flowers add more colour.



Ocimum basilicum 'Spicy'
'Spicy Globe' Basil

H: 6-12" 15-30cm Zone: 9
Dwarf, compact herb with dark, very fragrant green leaves. Has very tender leaves, excellent for eating fresh in salads.



Borago officinalis

Borage

H: 36" 90cm Zone: 9

A tall and vigorous annual easily recognised by its 'hairy' leaves and attractive blue star-shaped flowers. Cucumber flavour



Nepeta cataria

Catnip

H: 24-36" 60-90cm Zone: 3

Vigorous easy to grow perennial herb beloved by house cats. Medium green foliage is topped by small white flowers that bloom from spring to fall.



Matricaria recutita

Chamomile German

H: 6-12" 15-30cm Zone: 9

Sturdy, upright herb with fine textured, feathery aromatic foliage. Flowers resemble white daisies with large yellow centres. Fragrance and flavor resemble apples.



Anthriscus cerefolium

Chervil Curled

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 3

Delicate, mound-forming perennial herb. Bright green, fine textured, fern-like foliage is aromatic and tastes similar to anise.



Allium schoenoprasum

Chives

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 3

Grows in clumps of long, tubular leaves with spherical lavender flowers. Easy to grow; trim off bits as needed to enjoy its onion-like flavour.



Allium tuberosum

Chives Garlic

H: 18-24" 45-60cm Zone: 3

Also known as Chinese leeks, garlic chives impart oniony flavour with a distinctly garlicky overtone.



Chrysanthemum matricaire

Feverfew

H: 12-36" 30-90cm Zone: 4

Dwarf, mat-forming plant bearing aromatic bright green fern-like leaves topped with small, white daisy-like flowers with yellow centres.



Coriandrum sativum 'Santo'

Cilantro Santo

H: 12-24" 30-60cm Zone: 5

Aromatic herb that is great for using fresh or dried. Plants are slow to bolt for an extended harvest season.



Anethum graveolens 'Hera'

Dill 'Hera'

H: 24-36" 60-90cm Zone: 8

Bushy herb with fine textured, fern-like foliage. Used as flavouring fresh or dried to season fish, pickles, or other vegetables.



Marrubium vulgare

Horehound

H: 10-18" 25-45cm Zone: 2

Native herbaceous perennial in Europe, Asia and northern Africa. Grows on nutrient-poor, dry and sandy soils.

LAVENDER—LAVANDULA



'HIDCOTE BLUE' ENGLISH

Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote Blue'

H: 12-24" 30-60cm Zone: 5

A versatile perennial with fragrant purple blue flower spikes above mounds of aromatic grey-green foliage.



'MUNSTEAD' ENGLISH

Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead'

H: 48" 120cm Zone: 4

An attractive dwarf lavender with fragrant blue flowers.



'ROSEA ENGLISH'

Lavandula angustifolia 'Rosea'

H: 12-48" 60-90cm Zone: 5

Grown for its fragrant soft pink blossoms.



'FRAGRANT BUTTERFLY'

Lavandula stoechas pedunculata

'Fragrant Butterfly'

H: 16-18" 40-45cm Zone: 7

Impressive French stoechas lavender with rich magenta petals and dark bracts on slender stalks.



'SWEET DREAMS'

Lavandula angustifolia 'Sweet Dreams'

H: 16-20" 41-51cm Zone: 5

Fragrant spikes of deep-blue flowers spring through fall. Attracts bees, butterflies and hummingbirds.



'KEW RED'

Lavandula stoechas 'Kew Red'

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 6

Shrubby growth habit with a perennial that is wonderful in mixed borders. Showy pink and red blooms are a magnet for




LEMON BALM

Melissa officinalis

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 9

Leaves have a mild lemon scent. During the summer, small white flowers appear.




LEMON VERBENA

Aloysia triphylla

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 9

As a culinary herb, lemon verbena makes one of the best beverage teas, especially when blended with mint.



LIME BALM

Melissa officinalis 'Lime'

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 4

Very similar to lemon balm in appearance and growth but the scent is closer to lime. Use in beverages or fruit salads.





Marjoram Sweet

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 6
A hardy bushy annual with slender 4-sided red stems bearing ovate grey opposite leaves and clusters of tubular white flowers.

Gold Tipped Marjoram

H: 6-12" 15-30cm Zone: 5
A vigorous creeper with small, rounded green leaves edged in gold. Small, pink flowers in early to late summer.

Mint—Mentha

All mints are vigorous spreaders and should be contained

Apple Mint

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 5
Apple mint's wavy, gray-green leaves have a sweet, fruity aroma.

Chocolate Mint

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 3
Leaves have delightful minty chocolate flavour. Pick leaves frequently to suppress flowering.

Ginger Mint

H: 24-30" 60-75cm Zone: 5
Soft rounded, bright green fuzzy leaves splashed with golden-yellow. Has mild, faint ginger flavour and aroma.

Mojito Mint

H: 18-24" 45-60cm Zone: 4
Delightfully aromatic bright green foliage adorns this spreading herb.

Orange Mint

H: 18-24" 45-60cm Zone: 4
Dark green rounded leaves topped with spikes of small lavender flowers in summer. Leaves have a minty-orange fragrance and taste.

Pennyroyal Mint

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 5
Great for ground cover. Not a culinary herb and should not be ingested. Crushed leaves give off spearmint smell.

Peppermint

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 3
Sprawling mounds of purple-tinged green, aromatic foliage. Spikes of lavender flowers appear in midsummer.

Pineapple Mint

H: 12-24" 30-60cm Zone: 5
An attractive cream variegated form of applemint with a slight pineapple scent.

Mint—Mentha

All mints are vigorous spreaders and should be contained



Spearmint

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 4
Vigorous, bushy perennial herb with bright green, textured, aromatic foliage.

Mentha spicata



Strawberry Mint

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 3
Sturdy, compact herb with crinkled, bright green strawberry-scented foliage.

Oregano—Origanum



Origanum vulgare

Oregano

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 5
Bushy, shrub-like perennial herb. Aromatic, bright green leaves are oval-shaped, and small tubular lavender blooms appear in the summer.



Origanum vulgare 'Hot & Spicy'

Oregano 'Hot & Spicy'

H: 18-24" 45-60cm Zone: 6
Vigorous herb with highly aromatic, spicy flavored leaves topped by pink flowers in summer. Its intense flavor is great to spice up Mexican cuisine.



Origanum vulgare 'Aureum'

Oregano 'Golden'

H: 48-72" 120-180cm Zone: 5
A robust creeper with tiny, rounded leaves. Small pink or lavender to purple flowers stand out above the foliage in early to late summer.



Origanum vulgare hirtum

Oregano Greek Variegated

H: 12-24" 30-60cm Zone: 5
Highly decorative garden plant, attractive mound of aromatic foliage, covered with pink flowers for most of summer.

PARSLEY—PETROSELINUM



Petroselinum crispum

Curled

H: 12-18" 30-45cm

Zone: 5

Small, delicate perennial herb with bright green fern-like foliage. Used as a garnish, for seasoning, and for freshening breath.



Petroselinum crispum var. neapolitanum

Italian

H: 18-24" 45-60cm

Zone: 5

Small, delicate perennial herb with bright green fern-like foliage. Flavour is slightly peppery and stronger than the more common parsley.

ROSEMARY—ROSMARINUS



Rosmarinus officinalis
Rosemary

H: 48-60" 120-150cm

Zone: 6

Woody evergreen shrub bearing greyish-green, aromatic needle-like leaves. Grown for both its culinary and ornamental value. Use fresh or dried.



Rosmarinus officinalis 'Rex'
Rosemary 'Rex'

H: 36" 90cm

Zone: 6

An especially fragrant variety that can be used either fresh or dried.



Rosmarinus officinalis 'Spice Island'
Rosemary 'Spice Island'

H: 3-4' 90-120cm

Zone: 8

A tall, upright rosemary names for its very flavourful, grey-green, needle-like foliage. Use fresh or dried.



Rosemary 'Tuscan Blue'

H: 48" 120cm

Zone: 7

Be sure to plant Rosemary as close to your kitchen door as possible. Just brushing past the stems will release a wonderful fragrance. Rigid, upright branches display blue-violet flowers.

H: 18-24" 40-60cm

Zone: 7

Low growing evergreen shrub with aromatic, needle-like foliage.

SAGE—SALVIE ☀



Salvia officinalis

Sage

H: 24-36" 60-90cm Zone: 4

Semi-woody, shrubby perennial herb that grows in clumps of silvery green, fuzzy, aromatic foliage.

Spikes of lavender flowers appear in midsummer.



Salvia officinalis 'Aurea'

Allgold

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 6

A stunning bright gold evergreen bush, attractive in any border or herb garden.



Salvia officinalis 'Purpurascens'

Purple

H: 30-36" 75-90cm Zone: 5

Compact, shrubby perennial bearing purple spring leaves that turn green as they mature.



Salvia officinalis 'Tricolor'

Tricolour

H: 12-18" 30-45cm Zone: 6

Half hardy perennial evergreen. Leaves splashed with pink, white and green.

SAVORY—SATUREJA ☀



Satureja hortensis

Summer Midget Savory

H: 6-12" 15-30cm Zone: 7

Half hardy perennial herb with slender, erect stems, bronze leaves, and small pink flowers.



Satureja montana

Creeping Winter Savory

H: 12" 30cm Zone: 4

Strongly aromatic with glossy leaves that can be used fresh or dried in a variety of dishes.



Stevia rebaudiana

Sugarleaf Stevia

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 11

A wholesome alternative to processed sugar. Great to use in drinks, soups and meats.


Artemisia dracunculus

Tarragon 'French'

H: 24" 60cm Zone: 4

Perennial herb that is mainly used in sauces and vinegars, but also with chicken and egg dishes.

Thyme — THYMUS



Thymus 'Bertram Anderson'

Thyme 'Bertram Anderson'

H: 2-4" 3-10cm Zone: 4

Dwarf, compact perennial that spreads into thick mounds of golden, fragrant foliage.

Thymus 'Doone Valley'

Thyme 'Doone Valley'

H: 6" 15cm Zone: 4

Compact, spreading perennial that forms dense mats of green/yellow variegated, fragrant foliage. Lemon scent.

Thymus vulgaris

Thyme 'English'

H: 6" 15cm Zone: 4

Aromatic fresh or dried leaves can be used in meats, poultry, stews, soups, vegetables and beans.



Thymus vulgaris 'French'

Thyme 'French'

H: 6-8" 15-20cm Zone: 4

Purple to white flowers with narrow, fragrant green leaves. Scented foliage.



Thymus x citriodorus 'White Edge'

Thyme 'White Edge Lemon'

H: 4-12" 10-30cm Zone: 4

Delicious lemon scented with white edged leaves are highlighted by soft purple blooms in summer. Attracts bees.



Thymus 'Spicy Orange'

Thyme 'Spicy Orange'

H: 2-3" 3-8cm Zone: 4

Needle-shaped leaves with a strong spicy-orange fragrance, covered by small pink flowers in the summer.



Thymus vulgaris 'Aureus'

Thyme 'Golden Edge'

H: 6-10" 15-25cm Zone: 5

Golden-edged leaves are aromatic with a slight lemon scent. Does well in dry, sunny locations.
