Easy. Minimal walking, primarily flat surfaces, walkers ok.



Moderate. Walking short distances. Extended standing. Possibly uneven surfaces or a few stairs. No wheelchairs, walkers with approval.



More Difficult. Walking tours. Hikes up to 2 miles. Uneven surfaces. Possibly one or more flights of stairs. No wheelchairs or walkers.

People in wheelchairs or electric scooters may be accommodated on some trips. One of our favorite trips is back and better than ever! The Outback Kangaroo Farm, where they take the idea of a zoo to a whole new level. Our first stop will be a tour of the Stillaguamish Valley Pioneers Museum, which is keeping alive the heritage of the original homesteaders

of the river valley. After a picnic lunch, we'll take the kangaroo and exotic animal tour. You'll have the opportunity for an up close look at a variety of exotic animals. In addition to kangaroos, the farm houses everything from alpacas and flying squirrels to peacocks and wallaroos. We complete this adventure at our favorite restaurant in the area — The Restaurant at Rhodes River Ranch. The restaurant's unique dining atmosphere (it overlooks an indoor horse arena) may provide us with views of horse riding and training as we dine. NOTE: As the Kangaroo Farm is a working farm with dirt ground and geese/duck "hazards," please wear shoes appropriate for walking on a farm. The farm tour includes standing and walking on dirt paths and uneven terrain.




