The coordinator is in charge of cleaning

dishes and the facility at the Tumwater site. Additionally, the coordinator will help prepare meals, clean, and wash dishes at the Olympia site. The coordinator will be a team player and perform other duties as assigned.

The Food Service Kitchen Assistant:

- Assists Olympia kitchen staff in the preparation of meals to meet all program requirements, in a manner that complies with health and safety standards per local, state, and federal regulations.
- Packages, transports, and serves lunch to seniors at the Tumwater Old Town Senior Center.
- Washes dishes and cleans kitchen and dining rooms at the Tumwater Old Town Senior Center.
