Senate Candidate Lahmeyer Endorses Grellner

Oklahoma City—It's not often a candidate for the U.S. Senate will endorse another from the same state during the same election cycle, but it has happened in Oklahoma. Pastor and businessman Jackson Lahmeyer has endorsed fellow candidate Dr. Randy Grellner.

The reason for this atypical event is because Lahmeyer is squaring off against incumbent James Lankford, and Cushing doctor, farmer and rancher Grellner is battling for the seat being left vacant with the planned retirement of long time Senator Jim Inhoff.
