

THE BOARD OF NESS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
April 10, 2023

The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, April 10, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Travis Petersilie called the meeting to order with Commissioners Mark Davis, Dave Albers and County Clerk Lori Hertel in attendance.

Noxious Weed

Noxious Weed Director Phil Armstrong met with Commission to review employment application. Armstrong will arrange interview for next commission meeting. Discussion was held regarding spraying of weeds, effectiveness of spray with low moisture, and cost of spray. Air conditioning unit has been installed in Noxious Weed building.

Road and Bridge

Road and Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Ron Johnson presented the only bid on tires received from 4 requests that were sent out. From Kansasland Tires, 16 grader tires at \$1,600.00 per tire.

Motion: Upon the motion of Albers, seconded by Davis, Commission unanimously voted to accept bid from Kansasland Tires- 16 Bridgestone tires for \$1,600.00 per tire.

Landfill tipping fees of \$380.00 were collected March 28 thru April 1st, 2023. Johnson discussed ground testing report that was turned in recently. Next testing event will be in May with New company, Milco Environmental Services Inc.

Motion: Upon the motion of Albers, seconded by Davis, Commission unanimously voted to recess into executive session to discuss an employee incident pursuant to the nonelected personnel matter exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1) for a period of 5 minutes beginning at 10:05 a.m. (Davis, Albers, Petersilie, and Hertel in executive session). Regular session resumed at 10:10 a.m. No decisions were made.

Discussion was held on notification of potential road closure, review of items to list on Purple Wave, and weekly work schedule.
