

THE BOARD OF NESS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
May 1, 2023

The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, May 1, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Travis Petersilie called the meeting to order with Commissioners Mark Davis, Dave Albers and County Clerk Lori Hertel in attendance.

Commission

Commissioners Travis Petersilie and Dave Albers reported on meetings and conferences they attended last week.

Minutes and Correspondence

Minutes of regular meeting held April 24, 2023, was approved as corrected. Correspondence was reviewed and acknowledged.

Payment Under Protest

Commission reviewed and approved a payment under protest application as presented.

Road and Bridge

Ness County Road and Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Ron Johnson met with Commission. \$310.00 was collected in landfill tipping fees April 18th thru the 22nd.
