

THE BOARD OF NESS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
October 2, 2023

The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, October 2, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Travis Petersilie called the meeting to order with Commissioners Mark Davis, Dave Albers, and County Clerk Lori Hertel in attendance.

Minutes and Correspondence

Minutes of the Regular meeting held September 25, 2023, were approved as corrected. Correspondence was reviewed and acknowledged.

Road and Bridge

Ness County Road and Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Ron Johnson reported landfill tipping fees collected in the amount of \$305.00 from September 19th thru 22nd. 260 yards of sand, 675 yards of dirt, and 40 yards of rock was hauled from September 25th thru the 29th. Johnson presented weekly work schedule. Field Check Cost Estimate for Off-system 37 Bridge Replacement was discussed. KCAMP Risk Assessment inspection report was presented, corrections needed were discussed. Johnson discussed equipment repairs, replacing outdated electric box, and road concerns.
