March 25, 2024

The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, March 25, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Mark Davis called the meeting to order with Commissioners Travis Petersilie, Dave Albers, and County Clerk Lori Hertel in attendance.

Minutes

Minutes of the Regular Commission meeting held March 18, 2024, were approved as corrected. Correspondence was reviewed and acknowledged.

Road and Bridge

Ness County Road and Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Ron Johnson met with Commission Landfill tipping fees for March 12 thru March 16, amount of \$495.00. 1,825 yards of dirt was hauled March 18 thru March 22. Commission discussed with Johnson tractor lease or purchase and work schedule for the week. Clerk presented request from City of Ransom for help with clean-up day and tipping fees waived, May 16, 2024.

Motion: Upon the motion of Petersilie, seconded by Albers, Commission voted unanimously to waive tipping fees for City of Ransom on May 16th. Nusser Fuel submitted the required bill of lading on delivered fuel.
