The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, April 8, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Mark Davis called the meeting to order with Commissioner Dave Albers, Travis Petersilie and Deputy County Clerk Jennifer Lopez in attendance.

**Minutes**

Minutes of the Regular meeting held April 1, 2024, were approved as presented. Correspondence was reviewed and acknowledged.

**Commission**

Commission agreed to discontinue claim on damage to chiller due to deductible higher than repair costs. Discussion on membership fee to Kansas League of Municipalities with decision to not renew it. A 5-County meeting needs to be scheduled for April 24, 2024. Clerk will send email invitations.

**Road and Bridge**

Ness County Road and Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Ron Johnson met with Commission. Landfill tipping fees for March 26 thru March 29, amount of \$235.00. 2,260 yards of sand was hauled from April 1 thru April 5. Johnson discussed new Pay Clock system, hiring temporary summer help for mowing, and machinery repairs. Commission agreed to summer help, Johnson will start advertising for position.
