The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, June 24, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Mark Davis called the meeting to order with Commissioner Dave Albers, Travis Petersilie and County Clerk Lori Hertel in attendance.

Appraiser

Ness County Appraiser Kelly DesLauriers met with Commission.

Motion: Upon the motion of Albers, seconded by Petersilie, Commission unanimously voted to recess into executive session for nonelected personnel matter exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1) for a period of 10 minutes beginning at 9:05 a.m. (Davis, Albers, Petersilie, and DesLauriers in executive session). Regular session resumed at 9:15 a.m. No action taken.

Commission


Motion: Upon the motion of Albers, seconded by Davis, Commission voted unanimously to approve a one-time Payout as presented to Commission.
