

Strategic Education Workforce Development Survey on Employee Sentiment During the Great Resignation

Overview

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, employers experienced a mass exodus from the workforce whose repercussions continue to present them with many challenges. In fact, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that 4.5 million workers in the U.S. voluntarily quit their jobs in March of 2022 alone. While many may believe the Great Resignation has been caused by disgruntled employees trying to find better work, our research suggests otherwise. To better understand the employee sentiment and the root causes of the Great Resignation, Strategic Education commissioned a workforce development survey by Atomik research of more than 2,000 employees.

Methodology

The online survey was served to 2,009 employees in the United States. The margin of error fell within +/- 2 percentage points with a confidence interval of 95 percent. The fieldwork took place between March 17th and March 22nd, 2022. Atomik Research is an independent creative market research agency.
