TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By registering for Delhi Public School, Eldeco Model United Nations 2022 (hereafter referred to as “DPSEMUN” or “DPSEMUN 2022”), you agree to the following terms and conditions:

ELIGIBILITY

1. Registration for delegations takes place online via dpsemun.com/register
2. All individuals registered as delegates at DPSEMUN, under a delegation or individually, must be 12 years of age or older and enrolled in grade VII or above — or have graduated from high school during the academic year of 2021-22.
 - a. The Secretariat of DPSEMUN reserves the right to investigate the eligibility of any delegate and expel, without refund, any individual determined to be ineligible for participation as a delegate. Individuals who are to register must provide full and correct information about their person;
 - b. Schools/ Educational Institutions are required to send a delegation at a minimum of 6 delegates;
 - c. Each delegation is required to be led by a head delegate who shall act as the point of contact to the whole delegation for the staff of DPSEMUN.
3. Teachers or adults employed by educational institutions, are eligible to serve as faculty advisors to their respective delegations.
4. The registration process will be considered completed as soon as the online application via Google Forms has been submitted, all the payments have been made in full and have been verified by the Secretariat.

CONDUCT

1. All delegates should abide by the dress code while at DPSEMUN, which shall be specified day-wise in the conference handbook.
2. All delegates are expected to remain courteous and respectful while at DPSEMUN. Failure to abide by this rule shall result in a possible suspension from DPSEMUN. Necessary actions will

be taken against delegates who disrupt committee sessions or other conference events, antagonize guests or otherwise “disturb the peace”.

3. All faculty advisors are responsible for the safety, well-being, and conduct of their delegates.
4. DPSEMUN will not tolerate any instances of harassment or discrimination. Further, DPSEMUN will not tolerate any instances of inappropriate behaviour. If any delegate, member of the logistics team or advisor believes they have encountered harassment or discrimination, they are encouraged to bring it to the attention of the Secretary-General, or another member of the Secretariat. The Secretariat shall take necessary measures forthwith.

PORTFOLIO ALLOTMENTS

All delegations registered by the PRIORITY DEADLINE of September 20, 2022, will be given preference for portfolio allotments. All applications received after September 20 will be considered for acceptance on a first-come-first-serve basis. Country assignments will be issued within one week of registration. No delegation is guaranteed acceptance to DPSEMUN, even if the delegation registers before the Priority Registration Deadline. The portfolio allotment may deviate from the portfolio preference. Portfolios are allotted vis-à-vis the application and experience submitted. The final decision of portfolio allotments is upon the discretion of and reserved by the Secretariat of DPSEMUN.

FEES

1. The following fees and deadlines apply to all delegations of DPSEMUN:
 - a. A Delegation Fee of INR 2000 per delegate is to be charged;
 - b. DPSEMUN also welcomes international delegates. For international registration, kindly contact Shubhangi Kushwaha, Under-Secretary-General for Mass Media.

2. DPSEMUN requests that delegations pay all conference fees through the modes provided via the confirmation e-mail.
3. After registering the participant forfeits any rights to claim a refund for already paid fees.

EXCEPTIONS & VIOLATIONS

1. The Secretariat is only allowed to grant exceptions or extensions to conference policies and schedules. DPSEMUN is not liable for invalid statements made by other members of DPSEMUN staff regarding conference policies listed —and not listed— herein.

2. Violation of the policies listed in these terms and conditions may result in the revocation of assigned seats with no refund. Serious violations of these policies or those listed in the conference handbook regarding conduct may result in expulsion from the conference with no refund.

COVID-19

1. Due to the unpredictable nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, DPSEMUN reserves the right to impose health restrictions including vaccine, mask, and testing mandates. Delegates, faculty advisors, and other attendees who do not comply may have disciplinary action taken against them as determined by the Secretariat.
2. Attendees must be fully vaccinated, and are to produce a copy of their vaccine certification before the conference. Unvaccinated individuals will be deemed ineligible for registration.
