LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER

Ascension's Learning Resource Center is a multi-purpose area combining collection of fiction and nonfiction books, a media lab housing 18 Dell desktop computers, a quiet area for students to study, and a learning resource center directed by a teacher prepared to help students with their studies or supervise them as they make up work or tests. Students may visit the Learning Resource Center (LRC) on a free period or as referred by a classroom teacher. Classes may reserve the media lab for group computer work, or students may use it as a distance-learning lab.

General Library/Learning Resource Center Rules:

- 1) The LRC is open from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday Friday.
- 2) No food or drink is allowed in the LRC.
- 3) No boisterous behavior is permitted in the LRC.
- 4) The atmosphere in the LRC must always be conducive to study.
- 5) Any student not obeying the LRC rules is asked to leave and may, if the bad behavior is chronic, be prohibited from using the LRC for a period of time.
