It's all about Jesus

1 ACKNOWLEDGE

that God has not been first in your life, and ask Him to forgive your sins.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." -1 JOHN 1:9 (NIV)

2 BELIEVE

that Jesus died to pay for your sins and that He rose from the dead and is alive today.

"If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved." — ROMANS 10:9-10 (NLT)

"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name [Jesus] under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." - ACTS 4:12 (NIV)

"We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen as leep in him."-1 THESSALONIANS 4:14 (NIV)

3 INVITE

Jesus Christ to come into your life and be the Lord of your life.

4 ACCEPT

God's gift of salvation. Don't try to earn it.

Our relationship with God is not restored by anything we do, but on the basis of what Jesus already did for us.

Declaring OUTWARDLY WHAT HAPPENS INWARDLY

ONCE YOU HAVE MADE A
DECISION TO FOLLOW CHRIST
THE NEXT STEP IS WATER
BAPTISM. WE PRACTICE BAPTISM
BY IMMERSION IN WATER — THE
WAY JESUS WAS BAPTIZED AND
THE WAY THE BIBLE DESCRIBES.

BY BEING WATER BAPTIZED, YOU ARE:

TYPES OF COMMUNITY GROUPS

1 DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS

Discipleship groups meet in the homes of other Glory Bell Church members and are either sermon-based or book studies. In these groups individuals have the opportunity to develop deep and meaningful relationships, build community and be discipled.

2 INTEREST GROUPS

Some members join together because of their interests or passions. (sports, golfing, cooking, etc.)

We believe that everyone has areas of strength and gifting that could benefit others. The first step in becoming a Connect Group leader is to attend the Connect Group Leader Training. These classes are offered throughout the year to give you an overview of what it takes to start a group. You'll discover that it's easier than you think.

The Gospel is the ultimate demonstration of God's generous nature towards mankind. The Bible consistently teaches that God blesses us so that we may bless others.

"Just as you excel in everything... in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness... see that you also excel in the grace of giving." $- \ 2 \ \text{CORINTHIANS 8:7 (NIV)}$

FOUR AREAS OF GIVING

1 TIME

We should be generous with our time by pouring what God has lavishly given to us into people we meet and live with. Our multiple volunteer opportunities at Glory Bell Church allow a great outlet for generous giving of your time.

"Therefore be careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of your time, because the days are evil." — Ephesians 5:15-16 (NASB)

2 TALENT

We should generously give of the talents God has equipped us with, to help in the church and serve those around us.

"A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other." - I CORINTHIANS 12:7 (NLT)

During Step Three of the Growth Track we will further discuss and explore ministry gifts.

3 MIND

We should generously share the knowledge that God has given to each of us with people who know little about following Christ. We are taught in scripture that we should have the "mind of Christ," so we should think as He thought and give as He gave. (This changes us from former values to the core values of Jesus.)

"Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant he confirmed to your ancestors with an oath." —
DEUTERONOMY 8:18 (NLT)

4 TREASURE

We should be generous with our resources. God has richly blessed us to generously bless others and to establish His kingdom on the earth. By paying our tithe and giving our o erings we set ourselves in covenant with God to receive His best, which helps us give our best.

"If your gift is... giving, give generously." - ROMANS 12:8 (NLT)

CHURCH FINANCES

We practice tithing for the support of Christ's body, the Church, as God commands. We recognize that giving the rest 10 percent of our income is the Biblical standard of giving.

Many people love to give to God, but need to have confidence in the methods and purposes used by organizations to which they give. Therefore, there are a great number of people willing to give if they are able to see honesty, integrity and genuine spiritual values reflected in the lifestyles of their church leaders.

The giving of tithes and offerings is worship to Jesus Christ and is an expression of the relationship between the individual giver and the Lord. Funds are not "income only," they are worship, and must not be considered as a business transaction but as an expression of gratitude toward God.

"A tithe of everything... belongs to the Lord; it is holy to the Lord." - LEVITICUS 27:30 (NIV)

2 DRAWS ME CLOSER TO GOD

3 GIVING IS THE ENEMY OF POVERTY

"Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to be generous and willing to share. In this way they may take hold of the life that is truly life." — 1 TIMOTHY 6:17-19 (NIV)

4 STRENGTHENS MY FAITH

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding...

Honor the Lord by giving him the first part of your income, and he will 11 your barns to over owing." — PROVERBS 3:5, 9-10 (NIV)

5 INVESTMENT IN ETERNITY

3 GUIDANCE

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control." - GALATIANS 5:22-23 (NIV)

6 SPIRITUAL GIFTS

"There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit... Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit the message of

wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines." — 1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-11 (NIV)
