## APPROVAL PANEL GUIDELINES

<u>Approval Panel Purpose</u>: to ensure the resolution follows UN guidelines and clarifies the ideas of a delegate in order to enhance fruitful debate on the committee topic.

## Approval Panel should correct:

- 1. *MUN Resolution Formatting* → to follow UN resolution guidelines
- Grammar & Syntax → to make delegate's spelling, punctuation, & sentence structure clearer.
- Unclear Ideas → occasionally and only when necessary to help clarify the meaning of the delegate's ideas: a) improve poor English word choice, b) remove repetitious ideas &/or blatantly trivial content, and c) other items at the discretion of each Panel member.

## Approval Panel should **not** correct or change:

- 1. Delegate errant ideas e.g. historical inaccuracies, illogical reasoning, etc.
- 2. Grammar vagueness that may yield a variety of interpretations.

## Poor Quality Resolutions:

If the resolution is very poorly done, in consideration of time constraints and the quality of the resolution, the Approval Panel should either:

- a) ask the Main Submitter to come & edit the resolution with a member of the Panel.
  - b) return it to the delegate and tell them to revise it before resubmitting it.
