75 guides and scouts from 'Brejning Efterskole' (residential school) repairs a bus with team spirit and water from water bottles on their way to Jamboree Denmark 2022

75 guides and scouts from 'Brejning Efterskole' got good use of all their team competences, when their bus broke down on its way to Jamboree Denmark 2022 in Hedeland.

A quick guide and scout action with a socket spanner, adjustable spanner, and a single head wrench were attached to tubes and hoses in the bus's motor, followed by the contains of water from 75 water bottles into the coolant tank. Then the bus was ready to move on towards the jamboree.

"It was our team spirit that made it all succeed. We fixed

it in a couple of minutes" says five of the scouts that took lead in the rescue.

The bus with guides and scouts from 'Brejning' got engine troubles on its way to the big international Jamboree in Hedeland Naturpark on Zealand.

As the driver pulled into a lay-by and called the roadside service for assistance, the scouts investigated the engine and discovered that a tube to the coolant had come off.

Working as a team

"We discovered that there was water running out of the bus's

engine. We grabbed our tools. We always bring a lot of tools, so that we can handle everything. While the driver talked, we attached the tube to the coolant again and then emptied all our water bottles into the tank. It took no time at all. People were quick to bring their water bottles" says the five scouts, Tobias, Emil, Erik, Mikkel, and Aksel.

"It was not that hard. We did not black out. We work as a team after all. The driver was very impressed" the explanation goes.

In flourball war, you will have to fight with people from many different places to get the opponent's flag down to your base, all while avoiding the many flour bags flying in your direction.




F16s over SL2022
