

Topic Naming Conventions

Cheat Sheet

< private | public >.< domain >.< subdomain ...>.< dataname >

- #1 separate.with.dots.lowercaseonly
- **#2** Use **business domains and subdomains** as part of the name to give data a unique label.
- #3 Mark "official" topics that can be used outside your domain (e.g. after data quality measures have been taken) and "internal" topics.
- #4 Avoid using version numbers, team names, partition numbers or consumer/producer names as part of the topic name.

 Use application names only in absolutely exceptional cases and, if unavoidable, prefer "Domain Service Names" (see DDD).
- #5 Start your topic name with the company domain only in multi-tenant environments

 (for example: public.com.xeotek.marketing.website.pageviews).

Don't do too little, but don't overdo it either!
