About cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard drive by a web page server. Cookies contain information that a web server can later read in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

Some cookies will only be in usage if you use certain features or select certain preferences, and some cookies are essential to the Website and will always be used.

According to EU legislation, we can store cookies on your device, if they are strictly necessary for the operation of a Website. For all other types of cookies, we need your permission. You can at any time change or withdraw your consent from the cookies we collect.

Cookies usage

We use cookies and other technologies to ensure everyone using the Website has the best possible experience. For example, when you use our Website, we may place several cookies in your browser.

We use these cookies:

- to enable us to hold session information as you navigate from page to page within the Website;
- to improve your experience;
- to track and analyse usage and other statistical information.

If you elect not to activate cookies or disable cookies later, you may still visit our Website, but your ability to use some features or areas of those offerings may be limited.

Cookies we use

We use several types of cookies:

Necessary cookies

Necessary cookies help make a Website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the Website. The Website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
__cf_bm	This cookie is used to distinguish between humans and bots. This is beneficial for the Website, in order to make valid reports on the use of their website.	1 day
JSESSIONID	Preserves user's states across page requests.	Session

test-storage-access	This cookie has a “true” parameter, but it is not used in the work process.	Persistent
tolstoy-anonymousId	This cookie assigns a unique ID to each incoming visitor in the hash mode.	Session
tolstoy-anonymousId	Unique ID in the hash mode.	Persistent
tolstoyFirstSeenAtKey	Sets the date of the first visit of a new user.	Persistent
tolstoySessionCounter	Calculates the visits of a user towards his/her unique ID.	Persistent
tolstoyViewers	Calculates the number of impressions and plays.	Persistent

Statistics cookies

Statistics cookies help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
_ga	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the Website.	2 years
_gat	Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate.	1 day
_gid	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the Website.	1 day
events/1/#	Used to monitor Website performance for statistical purposes.	Session
jserrors/1/#	Registers the web site's speed and performance. This function can be used in context with statistics and load-balancing.	Session
vuid	Collects data on the user's visits to the Website, such as which pages have been read.	2 years

Preference cookies

Preference cookies enable a Website to remember information that changes the way the Website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region you are in.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
__ca__chat	Necessary for the functionality of the Website's chat-box function.	1 year

_ueuuid	Necessary for the functionality of the Website's chat-box function.	399 days

Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display relevant and engaging ads for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third-party advertisers.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
_fbp	Used by Facebook to deliver a series of advertisement products such as real time bidding from third party advertisers.	3 months
ads/ga-audiences	Used by Google AdWords to re-engage visitors that are likely to convert to customers based on the visitor's online behaviour across websites.	Session
