ESTRO's vision "Radiation Oncology, Optimal Health for All, Together" aligns with ABC Global Alliance's goal to improve and extend the lives of people living with advanced breast cancer. Relevant ESTRO work packages include the use of stereotactic radiotherapy to potentially increase progression-free survival in patients with oligometastatic disease (Oligocare) as well as optimising and integrating fast and effective palliative radiotherapy into pathways of care to maintain maximal quality of life in ABC patients. BO will highlight the potential of using palliative radiation therapy for more patients. Current work on guidelines for optimally integrating radiotherapy with systemic therapies is ongoing.

More broadly ESTRO brings together researchers in novel radiotherapy techniques (from protons to FLASH radiotherapy) that offer the potential to target anti-cancer treatment even more focally with lower risks of side-effects to patients. ESTRO's multidisciplinary community works together to robustly evaluate novel technologies and, where benefits are demonstrated, implement these as widely as possible for the benefit of all.
