The campsite is considered to be a quiet area, so we kindly ask that you keep noise to a minimum after 11:30pm



# House rules

## Electricity

There is a limited electrical supply at the campsite, however a USB powerbank is provided in the snug to charge a few phones at a time.

## Bins

Please keep this site tidy by taking your rubbish daily to the waste and recycling bins provided at the entrance to the farm by the concrete ramp.

Bin bags are provided for the bin by the sink.

## Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and clean up after your dog using a poo bag and dispose in the bin.

## Tents

Tents may only be pitched on the mown grass area. Please do not pitch your tents in the long grass.

## Sand pit

Our sandpit is open and has a few toys you are welcome to use.

## Farm

Please feel free to explore the farm and surrounding area but be aware that you are on a working farm.

Remember to always keep a look out for farm machinery and horses when you are exploring the farm and familiarize yourself with hazards marked on the displayed map.

**Do not enter fields with cattle or horses**

## Woodland play area

The woodland play area is open, but please be aware of the drainage ditch at the back of the woods.

## Games

There are two football goals, but you will need to bring your own ball!



# Facilities

## Lighting

- ▲ We have limited lighting on the site in the form of solar lights
- ▲ The fairy lights around the pantry and the loos come on as it gets dark
- ▲ The barn lights can be turned off/on using the grey switch by the snug
- ▲ Lights in the loos and at the sink are motion sensed
- ▲ Don't forget to bring your torch!

## Showers

**All showers are checked daily**

In the interest of the environment, please keep your showers as brief as possible!

We ask that all guests please wipe down the facilities after each use using the provided anti-bac wipes.

Please take care when showering as wet floors can be slippery.

Children must be accompanied by an adult when using the facilities.

## Kitchen, food storage and fridges

In the pantry, we have a fridge freezer, larder fridge, electric kettle and toaster. There's also plenty of food storage space on the shelves too. We do not provide any crockery, cutlery or glasses.

## Water

All water on site is drinkable. The black fridge has a chilled water supply and an ice machine.

## Toilets

We have 3 proper flushing toilets on site and do daily checks to replenish loo roll, hand towels, etc. If you're missing something, or our facilities aren't up to standard, please let us know.

- ▲ Loo rolls, hand soap and paper hand towels are provided
- ▲ Children must be accompanied by an adult when using facilities
- ▲ Please only flush toilet paper down the loos
- ▲ Cleaning products are available at the washing up sink for guests to clean the facilities themselves if they should wish to

## Washing up area

The light comes on after dark by sensor and washing up liquid and cloths are provided

# Fire & fire safety

## Communal fire pit

Campfires are only allowed in the provided firepits

- ▲ Please enjoy but use sensibly, particualry in times of drought
- ▲ Firelighters and kindling are provided
- ▲ Firewood can be purchased from the box
- ▲ You will need to bring your own matches/lighter and charcoal if you prefer
- ▲ BBQ swing arms and utensils are provided for you to BBQ your food
- ▲ Please DO NOT alter the chains on the firepit hood

## Fire safety

We are delighted to offer a campfire as we believe they are a big part of the camping experience! With this in mind, we have a few rules to ensure your experience is as safe as possible. Please familiarise yourself with the following points and our emergency procedure (displayed in the washing up area) so you can make the most of your camping experience whilst staying safe.

- ▲ Please use fire sensibly and be mindful of the risks it poses
- ▲ No smoking inside any of the tents/buildings
- ▲ Never leave a lit fire unattended
- ▲ Keep campfires safe and to a sensible size, never leave burning unattended
- ▲ Children should always be supervised around fire
- ▲ A fire is only allowed in the provided firepits
- ▲ There is a woodburner in the snug
- ▲ Fire extinguishers can be found in the barn and in the pantry
- ▲ There is a hand fire alarm bell on the side of the shop

# In the event of an emergency:

- ▲ DO NOT put yourself at risk
- ▲ Raise the alarm (Hand fire bell on side of shop building)
- ▲ Inform management (Lou, Ben or John Chandler) of the incident
- ▲ Summon immediate and appropriate assistance

In the event of fire, all staff and guests should exit if possible via the doors, using only the firefighting equipment to aid their own escape. Having got all of their party out of the tent guests are asked to gather on the sand horse ménage and contact management and emergency services.

*Describe the nature of the incident and provide clear directions to the site and agree a suitable meeting place with the emergency services.*

## Provide the fire brigade with the following details:

- ▲ Compressed gas located at back of shower/toilet block for gas boiler
- ▲ Fire extinguishers are located by the sink, in the barn and in the pantry (water and foam)
- ▲ Electricity isolation point is in the shop, toilet & shower
- ▲ Gas isolation point located at gas bottles.
- ▲ Mains water located behind shower block next to boiler
- ▲ Further water supplies from farm irrigation system

In the event of a severe accident, dial 999 and request an ambulance. Again, they will require the same contact information as above.

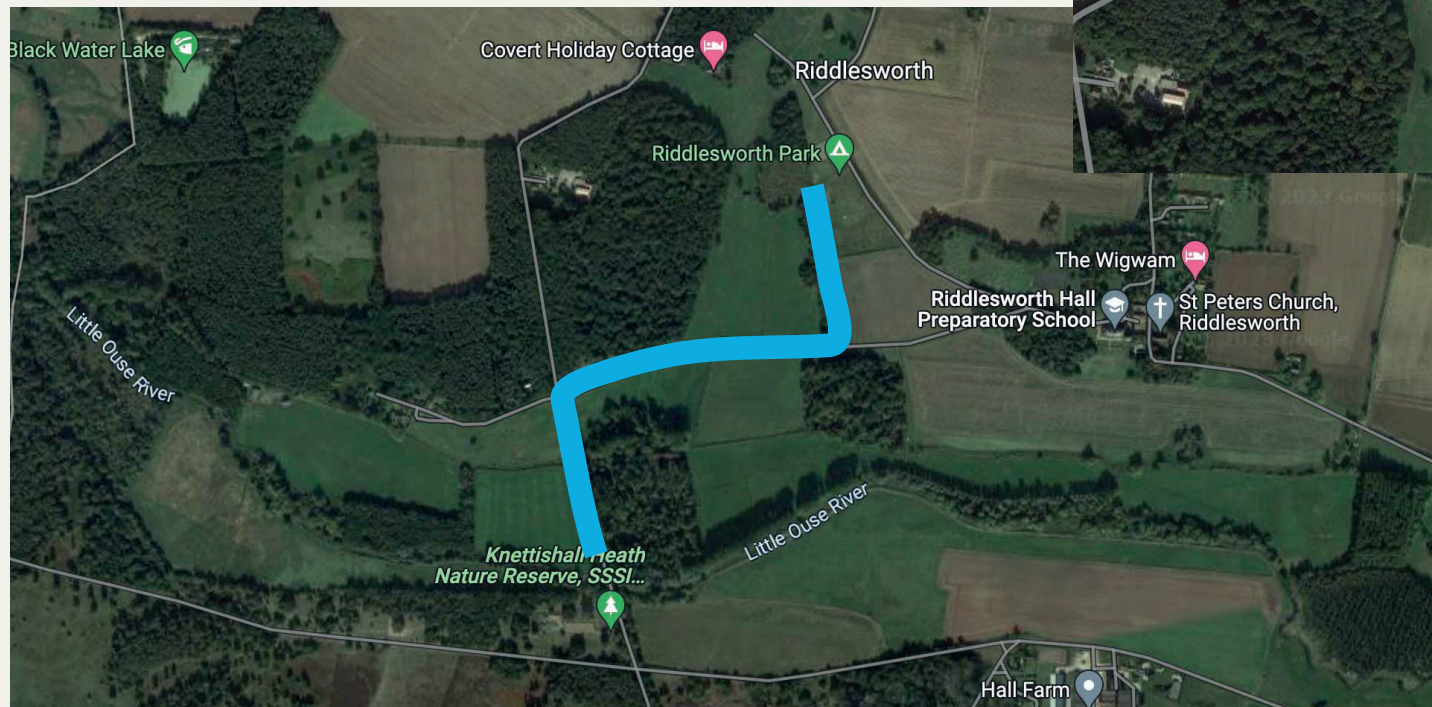


# Map & how to find us

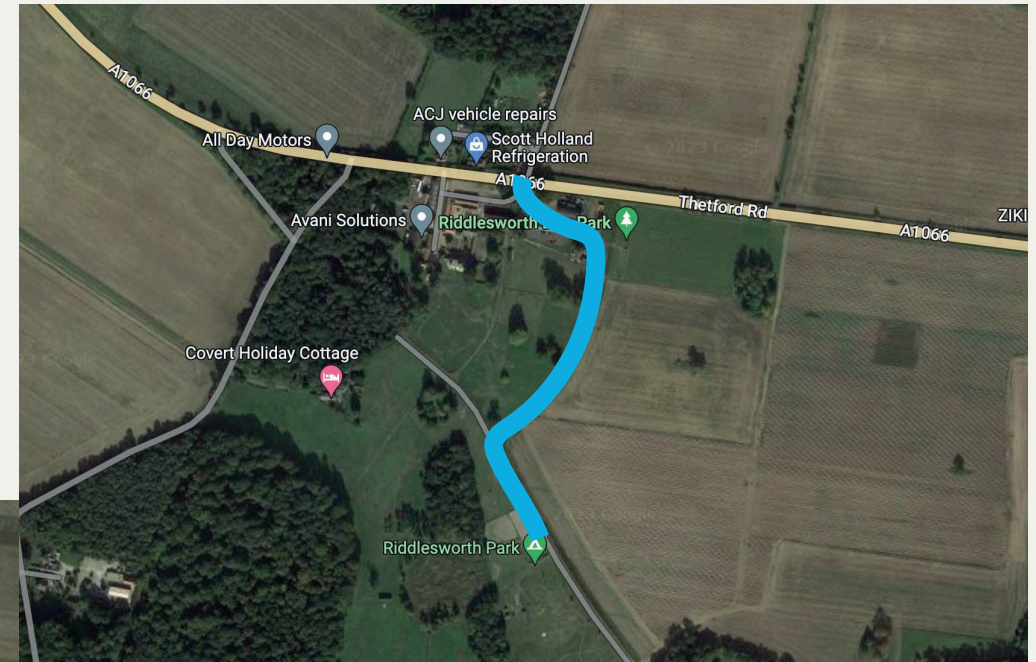
Find us off the A1066 Thetford to Diss road. Turn into the driveway opposite the red post box and bear left keeping to the right of the big black barn, then follow the signs!
