

TRAINING AND COMPETITION

We are here to develop you to the best player you can be. The normal weekly schedule consists of daily training under Bundesliga player development protocols in the mornings and evenings. Friendly matches of the academy team against professional academies or with your own German club team, which can be Rot-Weiss Erfurt, Carl-Zeiss Jena, SV 09 Arnstadt e.V. and other teams in the region.

The morning training generally consists of technical training in small groups to allow you a lot of repetitions to increase your technical skills. The evening sessions are in large groups and concentrate on tactics if you train in the academy. Alternatively, you can also train with your own club in the evenings.

Additional sessions include strength and coordination training, cognitive training, flexibility and speed training. These sessions are quite intense and are often as demanding on the cognitive as they are on the physical systems.

The coaching staff consists of highly qualified, German Federation licensed coaches that have demonstrated expertise in Bundesliga protocols for the development of young players.

With three grass and two artificial turf fields, the fitness center and the stadium, we'rre optimally equipped to train under professional conditions. Both training centers are located close to each other and can be reached on foot within a few minutes.



YOUR LIFE IN A BEAUTIFUL AREA

The Soccer Academy is in the center of Arnstadt. The district town of about 25.000 inhabitants offers not only sports activities but also cultural diversion. The closeness to the state capital Erfurt, about 20 kilometers away and easy to reach by public transport, offers further leisure opportunities. With an attractive old town and a modern city center, the state capital invites you to linger or store, as well as to visit a museum or theater. It is based in the center of Germany and your gateway to explore Europe.

If you are looking for recreation in nature, not only the Ilm district with its sights is an appealing destination but the Thuringian Forest can be reached quickly as well. The vacation region has numerous cycling and hiking trails, ski slopes and events for winter sports fans.



YOUR HOME - BOARDING SCHOOL

The heart of the Soccer Academy, besides the training fields, is the boarding house, which offers a small piece of home with its spacious facility. On more than 5000 square meters, there are 37 boarding rooms (which are divided into single and double rooms), teaching and learning rooms, rooms for leisure activities, a dining hall, a small restaurant with a bar and a beautiful outdoor area.

The boarding house is located within walking distance to the training ground "Am Obertunk" and the Jahn Stadium. The furnished rooms are bright, very homelike and offer space for a bed, desk and a closet. Each room has its own small entrance area and a bathroom including a shower.

Catering is provided by our in-house kitchen, which cooks fresh and athlete-friendly meals every day. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are completely covered, as well as packed lunches for longer trips! The boarding school also hosts a physiotherapy facility for optimal medical care, which can be used by the Soccer Academy. The boarding students are assisted by qualified educators and social supervisors, ensuring 24/7 supervision.


