WHY?

Images add visual appeal, engage readers, and can enhance the understanding of your content.

Add relevant, high-quality images to your HOW? blogs, product pages, and other areas of your site where they can complement the text.



2 OPTIMIZE IMAGE SIZE

WHY?

Large image files can slow down page loading, impacting user experience and SEO rankings.

HOW?

Use webp files, the lightest type of images, to keep your website loading quickly.

Utilize image compression tools without sacrificing quality.

NAME YOUR IMAGES DESCRIPTIVELY

WHY?

Image titles contribute to SEO by informing search engines about the content of the image.

Name the image in a way that is relevant to its content or the content of the page. HOW? Avoid generic names like "imagel.jpg"; instead, use descriptive titles like "vintage-red-car.jpg."

USE APPROPRIATE ALT TAGS

WHY?

Alt tags help search engines understand what the image is about and assist visually impaired users who may be using screen readers.

HOW?

Alt text should provide a clear and concise description of the image. Think of it as a brief caption that could stand in for the image if it failed to load.

CONSIDER LAZY LOADING

WHY?

Lazy loading defers the loading of offscreen images, improving initial page load time.

Use native browser features or simple HOW? plugins that load images only as they become visible on the user's screen.
