



Your privacy is critically important to us.

AT SQUADWARS WE HAVE A FEW FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES:

We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it. (We can't stand services that ask you for things like your gender or income level for no apparent reason.)

We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our products, or protect our rights.

We don't store personal information on our servers unless required for the on-going operation of one of our services.

Below is our privacy policy which incorporates these goals. It is SquadWars policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our websites.

Website Visitors

Like most website operators, SquadWars collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. SquadWars purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how SquadWars visitors use its website.

SquadWars also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses when challenger's register for an event and for users leaving comments on our site. SquadWars only discloses logged in user and commenter IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information as described below, except that IP addresses are visible and disclosed to the administrators of the registration system where the challenger signed up at.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Certain visitors to SquadWars websites choose to interact with SquadWars in ways that require SquadWars to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that SquadWars gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, when signing

up for an event, SquadWars collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor's interaction with SquadWars. SquadWars does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities, like registering for an event.

Aggregated Statistics

SquadWars may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its websites. For instance, SquadWars may monitor the most popular posts on the site or use spam screened by the Akismet service to help identify spam. SquadWars may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, SquadWars does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

SquadWars discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on SquadWars behalf or to provide services available at SquadWars websites, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using SquadWars website, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. SquadWars will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, SquadWars discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when SquadWars believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of SquadWars, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of SquadWars website, or if you've register for a SquadWars event and have supplied your email address, SquadWars may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with SquadWars and our events. We primarily use various socials to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of email to a minimum. Each email communication will include a link to unsubscribe from future emails. If you send us a request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. SquadWars takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. SquadWars uses cookies to help SquadWars identify and track visitors, their usage of SquadWars website, and their website access preferences. SquadWars visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using SquadWars website,

with the drawback that certain features of SquadWars websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.

Business Transfers

If SquadWars, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, or in the unlikely event that SquadWars goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of SquadWars may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this policy.

Ads

Ads appearing on any of our websites may be delivered to users by advertising partners, who may set cookies. These cookies allow the ad server to recognize your computer each time they send you an online advertisement to compile information about you or others who use your computer. This information allows ad networks to, among other things, deliver targeted advertisements that they believe will be of most interest to you. This Privacy Policy covers the use of cookies by SquadWars and does not cover the use of cookies by any advertisers.
