**Beginning August 13 – Services at 8:30, 10:00, and 11:30am!**

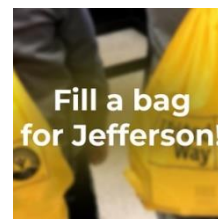
One of the reasons we want to add a third service is to provide plenty of empty seats so we can invite people to join us as we worship God together.

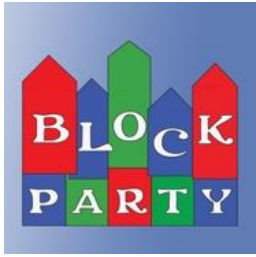
