## I Sure Enjoy The Mountains

Or

## Which Is Higher, Our Mountains Or The Number of People We've Murdered?

Or

## Do Any of Us Possess The Values That Our Founding Fathers Possessed?

## Hey America, Alaska, and Washington State Residents:

For a four-year period, my family and I lived Northwest of Seattle in the San Juan Islands. The San Juans, make up an absolutely beautiful portion of YeHoVah's creation. Pioneer Peak stands at 6,398 feet above sea level, and its base is very near sea level, therefore it is very impressive to view.
