God In American Politics-Alaskan U.S. Senate Seat Race: Joe Miller-Lisa Murkowski-Scott McAdams

• Protection of Personal Sovereignty: Joe Miller-highest score

The issue of personal sovereignty is extremely important. It is exactly what the entire Bill of Rights was created to protect and preserve. • Idea of Sarah Palin For President: Lisa Murkowskihighest score


