KM Asia Conference is calling for abstracts

The conference committee invites abstract submissions for presentation at the 2023 GLINK KM Asia conference run by the Knowledge Management Global Network (KMGN), and to be held in Indonesia from 17th-19th of October 2023.

Australasia has a strong Knowledge Management community and this year's conference theme is "KM End to End". The goal is to cover both intermediate to advanced topics, bridging the gap between theory, R&D and KM Practice. Implementation Case Studies will be considered as well as presentations of workshops. Key topic areas might include:

- KM Strategy & Balance between human, process and technology,
- Gaining buy in and engagement from senior leadership,
- Understanding the threats and opportunities from new technologies like graph databases, machine learning and chatGPT,
- The link between KM, Change Management and Digital Transformation, including how to measure the behaviour impact of KM programs,
- The inclusion of culture in KM system design,
- Ways to embed KM principles and theory into organisational processes,
- Turning the excuse of insufficient time into a driver for KM success
- How KM makes a difference to productivity and profitability in organisations.

The first day (17 Oct) will be in Bahasa Indonesia including a combination of presentations and workshops. The second and third days (18 & 19 Oct) will be in English and include 4 Presentations, 8 concurrent workshops (4 each day) and 2 discussion panels with a gala networking dinner on the second evening.

Abstracts for papers, presentations, and workshops submitted will be from 350-500 words by 5th of June. They will then be subject to peer review and accepted or declined by the Conference Organising Committee.

The selection criteria includes:

- Relevance to the conference theme,
- Accuracy and originality of ideas,
- Practicality of design and implementation,
- Workshop interactivity and engagement,
- Significance of the contribution, and
- Quality of presentation.

Accepted abstract authors will then be required to submit a full paper or presentation by the 1st of August 2023, with feedback & revisions provided by peer review and the Conference Organising Committee soon after.

All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings and presented during the technical sessions. All presenting authors may attend the conference free of charge. Presentations and workshops will be conducted in-person. Please note, the conference will not be streamed live online; however, all presentations will be recorded for viewing post-conference by attendees.
