



About the P.S. ARTS Program at Jean-Michel Basquiat: King Pleasure©

- The 100-minute experience consists of a 45-minute self-guided tour of the galleries and a hands-on art lab.
- There are two time slots that can accommodate 50 students each:
 - Group I will tour the exhibition from 9:15 - 10:00 AM and participate in an art lab from 10:00 - 10:55 AM
 - Group II will tour the exhibition from 10:00 - 10:45 AM and participate in an art lab from 10:45 - 11:45 AM

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

- Buses will drop students off at the main entrance of The Grand LA located at 100 South Grand Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Pick-up will occur in the same location.
- School groups will form a line at the entrance to the exhibit. Teachers and chaperones should divide students into groups of 10 before lining up at the entrance of the exhibition, located in the courtyard.
- School leaders should formulate a plan of where all students are to meet upon completion of the exhibit. We recommend the outdoor courtyard near the exhibition as a meeting point.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

- No backpacks are allowed.
- No food, drinks, or gum are allowed on the exhibition premises.
- No running, no sitting on the floor, and no leaning on walls or display cases.
- Be aware of other students and visitors who may be trying to look at the same thing as you.
- Keep a safe distance between you and each work of art. This helps to avoid accidental touching or bumping.
- Practice using quiet voices.
- There is a single restroom in the courtyard of the Grand, as well as additional restrooms on the 6th floor, above the exhibition. Students must be accompanied by a chaperone when leaving the exhibition to use the restroom.
- Note that while the exhibition is indoors, the art-making portion of the visit takes place outdoors. Please come prepared according to the weather.
