The Whittier track has received some electrical maintenance that is long overdue. Thanks to Steve O'Donnell and Dave Lundegard. The speed readout clock has been jumping around and not working at all. We changed the center

post sensor and that helped for a little while. We would still get inconsistent readouts on the display clock. The suspect was the connectors wiring at the center post. Steve and Dave did some surgery, pulling up the connector plate and stripping the wire back to get a clean hookup on the new gold plated plugins. We switched out the 7.5 volt battery pack that I would have to charge all the time and put a nine volt inside the sensor box. We also changed the connectors at the timing hut power box. This has been long overdue and now the clock works great. The next problem is the laptop computer. It's old school with a ribbon tape from the timer box to the computer port. Modern laptops do not have this hookup. The last time the laptop went out, I found an old one on Ebay. That was eight years ago. Now, the latest glitch is you have to re-boot a few times to get to the start up menu. Once everything was up and running, there were no problems for the days racing. The timer clock works, lap count-

er works, and all data is correct. Congratulation to Dick Hughes who did a solid 201 MPH with his new world class kit car from Europe that Dave Lundegard has been importing. I did the final assembly and, after Steve O'Donnell tuned the motor, the car finally came on line. The pan is machined from solid stock and everything fits like a glove. The carbon fiber top is flawless. We have one more session at Whittier to get cars up to speed for the NY Nationals. About 50 cars are entered with some guests from Europe & Australia. We always get a good turnout for the Nationals but the truth is that tether car racing in the U.S.A. is on the way out. Anderson has a hand full of people running and Whittier has the same with a few new people interested but not dedicated enough to come out to the track twice a month to run. That brings me to the New York track. Nick Tucci seems to be the only one left holding the wire, with no one to help push. I am hopeful the local racers will come out to help. I'm looking forward to competing at Cedar Creek Park, in Seaford New York

2017 Australian Championships

A cloudy Winter's day in Brisbane greeted racers attending the 2017 Australian Championships, but it didn't have a negative effect on speeds with two new Australian records being set on the day.

Rob Buckley took out 10 cc A Grade (Class V) with a new record speed of 341.102 km/hr (211.951 miles/hr) and John Walker raised his 5 cc A Grade (Class IV) record to 304.878 (189.442 miles/hr). Ron Clydesdale continued his purple patch with personal best speeds in both 10A and 5A, and Allan Barnes' hard work paid off with a PB to win 3.5 cc A Grade (Class III). The 2.5 cc A Grade (Class II) went to Ron Clydesdale's recalcitrant Picco 15, and the lone New South Welshman in the form of Kevin Barker was unchallenged for first place in 1.5 cc A Grade (Class I).

Unpiped classes displayed some fast speeds too, with Scott Clydesdale taking out 10 cc C Grade (open wheel, side exhaust and straight fuel) and 10 cc D Grade (open wheel, ringed engine and straight fuel) with near record speeds. Tony Peacock's venerable OPS 29 Denneler car took out the top prize in 5 cc B Grade removing Eddie Mitchell from his usual spot, and Geoff Offer once again prevailed in 3.5 cc M Class (open wheel, spur gear and straight fuel).

Nominated speed was a Clydesdale benefit, with Scott, Jack and Ron taking the top three places... The first time QMRCC's youngest member Jack has finished on the podium.
