We started with a practice session on Wednesday with some very fast speeds recorded by the European crew. It was the start of a busy week as most of us went up to Fresno on Friday and Saturday for the Sabbatini Collecto. We then came home late Saturday to get ready for the Sunday races.

The weather was perfect and we started off with a 10 car field in the 10 cc World Class division. Tonu Sepp from Estonia posted a 204 MPH average and the rest of us chased that all day. On the 3rd heat, Steve Morse got to 197 and Dave Lundegard finished at 196.

Tonu Sepp also won the 5 cc class and his brother Mart Sepp took the 3.5 cc class. Lembit Vaher was best in the tiny 1.5 cc cars with a 164 MPH run. Locals Rich Democh and Glen Dye posted some good speeds in chasing the Estonians.

There was a good turnout in the AMRCA classes with an exceptional run by Kevin Wells with his electric car at 187 MPH.

In all it was a great day of tether car racing with three complete heats finished, after which we presented the European visitors with commemorative plaques marking the occasion. It is always interesting to meet with the tether car racers from other countries. We sometimes have a hard time getting a good turnout of the local racers yet the Estonians and Otto Strobel were racing in Australia the week before they came here. Speaking of travelling, we would like to thank all the West Coast racers that came down from Northern California and Washington State for the event
