Proposed vs. Passed: What Medicare Changes Are Actually Happening in 2021?

On August 3, 2020, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released its annual proposed rule for services paid under the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS) during the 2021 calendar year. This rule also includes proposed changes to the Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) program for the 2021 performance year—which will ultimately impact participants' 2023 Medicare payments. This session will explain all of these proposed changes as well as

their impact on outpatient therapy services overall and the financial stability of individual practices. This session will also provide updates regarding the

Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage (ABN); TRICARE and low back pain; ICD-10-CM codes for fiscal year 2021; and much more.
