

## **Brigshaw High School Celebrates Students' Achievements with BEST RESULTS EVER in first exams since 2019.**

Staff and students are celebrating at Brigshaw High School with the first set of exam results in three years following the Covid pandemic. The school is delighted and very proud that students' hard work, efforts and resilience have been rewarded.

- 55% of students achieved a grade 5 or above in English & Maths (up from 41% in 2019 and higher than 2021)
- 75% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in English & Maths (up from 67% in 2019 and higher than 2021)
- 99 Grade 9s were awarded at GCSE and 5 D\*s awarded at level 2 BTEC
- 72% achieved 5 or more passes at 4+ including English and Maths (up from 67% in 2019 and higher than 2021)

2 students each hold an impressive set of ten grade 9s.

Other top performers achieved:

- 9 Grade 9s and 1 Grade 8
- 7 Grade 9s, 2 Grade 8s, 1 Grade 5
- 5 Grade 9s, 1 Grade 8s, 3 Grade 7s
- 4 Grade 9s, 4 Grade 8s, 1 Grade 7
- 4 Grade 9s, 4 Grade 8s, 1 Grade 7 and 1 Grade 6
- 4 Grade 9s, 3 Grade 8s, 2 Grade 7s and 1 Grade 5
- 4 Grade 9s, 3 Grade 8s, 1 Grade 7, 1 Grade 6, 1 Grade 5
